1 Ball (A)

**Fun Fur (Article #320). 100% Polyester; package size:
Solids: 1.75 oz/50g; 64 yd/58m balls
Prints: 1.5 oz/40g; 57 yd/52m balls
Exotics: 1.75 oz/50g; 55 yd/50m balls (**Note:** Exotics
shades are lay flat to dry)*



**Lion® Suede (Article #210). 100% Polyester; package
size: **Solids:** 3.00 oz./85g; 122 yd/110m balls
Prints: 3:00 oz/85g; 111 yd/100m balls*



GAUGE:

12 sts = 4 inches [10 cm] with 1 strand each A & B held together in Garter st (k every row) on larger needles.

13 sts = 4" [10 cm] with (C) in St st (k on RS, p on WS) on smaller needles. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

COLLAR

With larger needles and 1 strand each A and B held together, cast on 45 sts. Work 4 rows in Garter st (k every row). Increase 3 sts evenly across next row—48 sts. Repeat last 5 rows 3 times more—57 sts. Work even until piece measures 5" [12.5 cm] from beginning. Bind off.

LINING

With smaller needles and C, cast on 49 sts. Beginning with a purl row, work 3 rows in St st (k on RS, p on WS). Inc 2 sts evenly across next (knit) row—51 sts. Rep last 4 rows 2 times more—55 sts. Work 3 rows in St st. Inc 3 sts evenly across next row—58 sts. Rep last 4 rows once more—61 sts. Work even until piece measures 5" [12.5 cm] from beg. Bind off.

FINISHING

With WS tog, and matching edges, sew lining to collar. Weave in ends. Cut ribbon in half. Sew a length of ribbon to center of each Front edge.
