Made from several scarves sewn together, it has a fun and funky look with chevrons of various widths!

**SKILL LEVEL:** Intermediate

**SIZE:** One Size  
About 35 x 50 in. (89 x 127 cm)

**CORRECTIONS:** (applied Jun 11, 2010)

Bill of Materials updated to include Dusty Purple.

**MATERIALS**

- 860-147 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Purple  
2 Balls (A)
- 860-145 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Eggplant  
2 Balls (B)
- 860-144 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Magenta  
2 Balls (C)
- 860-146 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Dusty Purple  
2 Balls (D)
- 860-143 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Antique Rose  
2 Balls (E)
- 860-140 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Dusty Rose  
2 Balls (F)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size J-10
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

**GAUGE:**

Scarf = 7 in. (18 cm) wide; 6 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) over pattern. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

**STITCH EXPLANATION:**

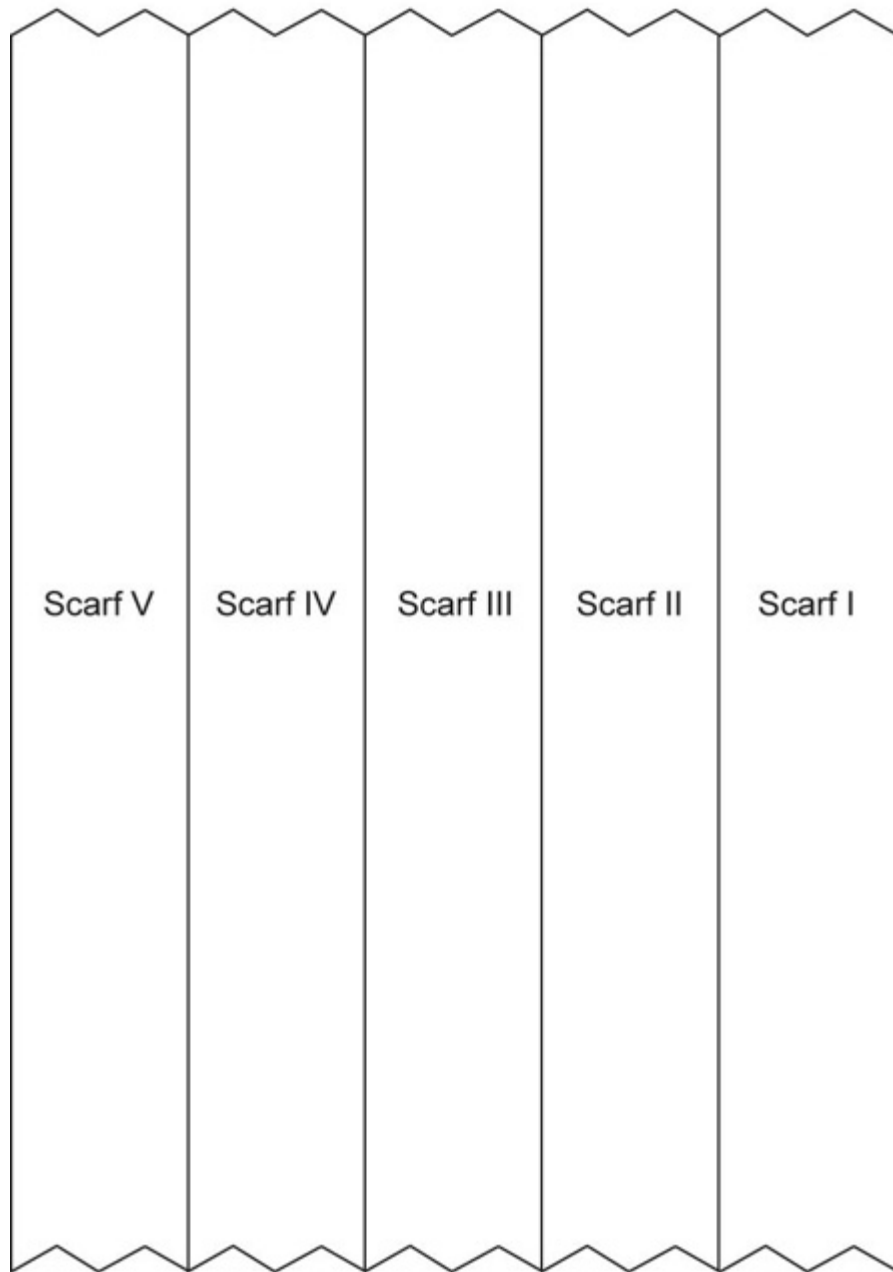
**PATTERN STITCH**

**Chevron Pattern (worked over 25 sts)**

**Row 1:** Ch 3, turn, sk first 2 dc, dc in next 4 dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next 5 dc, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 5 dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next 4 dc, sk next dc, dc in top of turning ch.  
Repeat Row 1 for Chevron Pattern.

**NOTES:**

To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st.



## **AFGHAN**

### **Scarf I**

With F, ch 26.

**Foundation Row:** Dc in 4th ch from hook, dc in next 3 ch, 3 dc in next ch, dc in next 5 ch, sk next 2 ch, dc in next 5 ch, 3 dc in next ch, dc in next 5 ch.

With F, work 3 rows in Chevron Pattern; change to D in last st of last row.

Continue working in Chevron Pattern changing colors as follows:

8 rows with D, 6 rows with E, 4 rows with C, 2 rows with B, 8 rows with A, 4 rows with F, 2 rows with D, 6 rows with E, 2 rows with C, 8 rows with B, 4 rows with A, 8 rows with F, 6 rows with D, 6 rows with E. Fasten off.

### **Scarf II**

Make as for Scarf I, change colors as follows:

4 rows with D, 8 rows with E, 6 rows with C, 4 rows with B, 2 rows with A, 8 rows with F, 4 rows with D, 2 rows with E, 6 rows with C, 2 rows with B, 8 rows with A, 4 rows with F, 8 rows with D, 6 rows with E, 6 rows with C. Fasten off.

### **Scarf III**

Make as for Scarf I, change colors as follows:

4 rows with E, 8 rows with C, 6 rows with B, 4 rows with A, 2 rows with F, 8 rows with D, 4 rows with E, 2 rows with

C, 6 rows with B, 2 rows with A, 8 rows with F, 4 rows with D, 8 rows with E, 6 rows with C, 6 rows with B. Fasten off.

#### Scarf IV

Make as for Scarf I, change colors as follows:

4 rows with C, 8 rows with B, 6 rows with A, 4 rows with F, 2 rows with D, 8 rows with E, 4 rows with C, 2 rows with B, 6 rows with A, 2 rows with F, 8 rows with D, 4 rows with E, 8 rows with C, 6 rows with B, 6 rows with A. Fasten off.

#### Scarf V

Make as for Scarf I, change colors as follows:

4 rows with B, 8 rows with A, 6 rows with F, 4 rows with D, 2 rows with E, 8 rows with C, 4 rows with B, 2 rows with A, 6 rows with F, 2 rows with D, 8 rows with E, 4 rows with C, 8 rows with B, 6 rows with A, 6 rows with F. Fasten off.

#### FINISHING

Sew Scarves together following Assembly Diagram, using yarn to match color of one of the Scarves being joined. Weave in ends.
