SKILL LEVEL: Easy

SIZE: One Size
About 9 in. (23 cm) across

CORRECTIONS: None

MATERIALS

- 760-152 Lion Brand Lion Cotton Yarn: Espresso
1 Ball (A)
- 760-133 Lion Brand Lion Cotton Yarn: Paprika
1 Ball (B)
- 760-159 Lion Brand Lion Cotton Yarn: Mustard
1 Ball (C)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size H-8
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

GAUGE:

17 sc = 4 in. (10 cm)

EXACT GAUGE IS NOT ESSENTIAL FOR THIS PROJECT

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

WASHCLOTH

With A, ch 4, join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 6 sc in ring, join with sl st in first sc, turn.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each sc around, join with sl st in first sc, turn - 12 sc.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in first sc, 3 sc in next sc, * sc in next sc, 3 sc in next sc; rep from * around, join with sl st in first sc, turn - 24 sc.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join with sl st in first sc, turn.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in each of the first 2 sc, 3 sc in next sc, * sc in each of the next 3 sc, 3 sc in next sc; rep from * 4 more times, sc in last sc, join with sl st in first sc, turn - 36 sc.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join with sl st in first sc, turn.

Change to B.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, sc in each of the first 3 sc, 3 sc in next sc, * sc in each of the next 5 sc, 3 sc in next sc; rep from * 4 more times, sc in each of the last 2 sc, join with sl st in first sc, turn - 48 sc.

Rnd 8: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join with sl st in first sc, turn.

Rnd 9: Ch 1, sc in each of the first 4 sc, 3 sc in next sc, * sc in each of the next 7 sc, 3 sc in next sc; rep from * 4 more times, sc in each of the last 3 sc, join with sl st in first sc, turn - 60 sc.

Rnd 10: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join with sl st in first sc, turn.

Rnd 11: Ch 1, sc in each of the first 5 sc, 3 sc in next sc, * sc in each of the next 9 sc, 3 sc in next sc; rep from * 4 more times, sc in each of the last 4 sc, join with sl st in first sc, turn - 72 sc.

Rnd 12: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join with sl st in first sc, turn.

Change to C.

Rnd 13: Ch 1, sc in each of the first 6 sc, 3 sc in next sc, * sc in each of the next 11 sc, 3 sc in next sc; rep from * 4 more times, sc in each of the last 5 sc, join with sl st in first sc, turn - 84 sc.

Rnd 14: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join with sl st in first sc, turn.

Rnd 15: Ch 1, sc in each of the first 7 sc, 3 sc in next sc, * sc in each of the next 13 sc, 3 sc in next sc; rep from * 4 more times, sc in each of the last 6 sc, join with sl st in first sc, turn - 96 sc.

Rnd 16: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join with sl st in first sc, turn.

Rnd 17: Ch 1, sc in each of the first 8 sc, 3 sc in next sc, * sc in each of the next 15 sc, 3 sc in next sc; rep from * 4 more times, sc in each of the last 7 sc, join with sl st in first sc, turn - 108 sc.

Rnd 18: Ch 1, sc in each of the first 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc, * sc in each of the next 17 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * 4 more times, sc in each of the last 9 sc, join with sl st in first sc, turn - 114 sc.
Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
