SKILL LEVEL: Easy

SIZE: One Size

About 10 x 35 in. (25.5 x 89 cm)

MATERIALS

- 790-375 [Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Candy Apple](#)
1 Ball (A)
- 790-412 [Lion Brand Homespun: Pearls](#)
1 Ball (B)
- [Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size I-9](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

GAUGE:

13 sc = about 4 in. (10 cm).

EXACT GAUGE IS NOT ESSENTIAL TO THIS PROJECT.

NOTES:

1. Runner is made from 5 rectangle Blocks that are seamed together. Creating individual Blocks adds design interest to the Runner, while using only simply crochet stitches.
2. Our pattern provides the opportunity for your own design input with your choice of stitches in each Block.
3. Border is crocheted, then embroidered accents are added.
4. Yarn amounts are sufficient to make additional Blocks should you wish to make a larger Runner.

FIRST BLOCK

Note: Instructions are for one rectangle Block. You will need to make 4 more Blocks to make a 10 x 35 in. (25.5 x 89 cm) Runner.

First Section

With A, ch 20.

Row 1: Dc in 3rd ch from hook and in each ch across.

Row 2: Ch 3, turn, dc in each dc across.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 7 in. (18 cm).

Fasten off.

Second Section

From right side, join A with sl st in one corner, ready to work along one side (either ends of rows or beginning of rows) of first section.

Row 1: Ch 3, work dc evenly spaced along side of first section.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Row 3: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 until Block measures about 10 in. (25.5 cm) wide.

Fasten off.

Work 4 more Blocks as follows:

Work first and second sections to same measurements as First Block, working rows in dc or sc, or alternate rows of dc and sc. If desired, you can simply work 4 more of First Block.

FINISHING

Sew Blocks together to make Runner.

Border

From right side, join A with a sl st anywhere along outside edge of Runner. Work sc evenly spaced around edge, join with sl st in first st. Fasten off.

Embroidery

With B, embroider straight st 'X's' as desired. For snowflake, with B embroider a straight st 'X', then embroider a vertical line through center of X for a total of 3 crossed lines. With B, embroider a small, straight st 'V' at ends of each line.

Weave in ends.
