SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference About 18 in. (46 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

MATERIALS

- 545-205 Lion Brand Landscapes: Apple Orchard
1 Ball
 - Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
 - Pom pom Maker
 - Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- *Landscapes (Article #545). 100% acrylic; package size: 3.50oz/100.00 gr. (147yds/134m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

9 dc + 7 rnds = 4 in. (10 cm)

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

Beret is worked in joined rnds, beg at top. Do not turn at beg of rnds.

BERET

Ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 4 (counts as first tr in this rnd and in all following rnds), work 19 tr in ring; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 20 tr.

Rnd 2: Ch 4, working into sp between sts, tr in next sp, then work 2 tr in each sp around; join with sl st in first sp of this rnd – 40 tr at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 3: Ch 4, working in the sp between sts, 2 tr in first sp, *tr in next 2 sps, 2 tr in next sp; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sp of this rnd – 55 tr.

Rnd 4: Ch 3 (counts as first dc in this rnd and in all following rnds), working in the sp between sts, dc first sp, *dc in next sp, 2 dc in next sp; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sp of this rnd – 83 dc.

Rnds 5-7: Ch 3, working in the sp between sts, dc in each sp around; join with sl st in first sp of this rnd.

Rnd 8: Ch 3, working in the sp between sts, sk first sp, dc in next 2 sps, *sk next sp, dc in next 4 sps; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sp of this rnd – 67 dc.

Rnd 9: Ch 3, working in the sp between sts, sk first sp, dc in next sp, *sk next sp, dc in next 4 sps; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sp of this rnd – 54 dc.

Rnd 10: Ch 3, working in the sp between sts, sk first sp, dc in next sp, *sk next sp, dc in next 3 sps; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sp of this rnd – 41 dc.

Rnds 11 and 12: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in beg ch.
Fasten off.

FINISHING

Following package directions, make a large pom-pom and tie to top of Beret.
Weave in ends.
