1 Ball (A)

1 Ball (B)
- 135-158 [Lion Brand Hometown USATM](#)  
Yarn: [Pittsburgh Yellow](#)  
1 Ball (C)

Yarn: [Los Angeles Tan](#)  
1 Ball (D)

#### **GAUGE:**

1 ripple = about 4 in. (10 cm).

#### **STITCH EXPLANATION:**

**dc3tog (dc 3 sts together)** Yarn over, insert hook into st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops. (Yarn over, insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through 2 loops) twice, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook.

**sc3tog (sc 3 sts together)** Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. (Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop) twice. Yarn over, draw through all 4 loops on hook.

#### **NOTES:**

1. This Scarf is worked in a ripple crochet pattern. The ripple pattern is easy to do, but it's important to remember that you may need to work several rows before the ripple pattern becomes clear.
2. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops to complete st. Fasten off old color.
3. Weave in ends as you go.



## SCARF

With A, ch 18.

**Row 1:** Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 2 ch, sc3tog, sc in next 2 ch, 3 sc in next ch, sc in next 2 ch, sc3tog, sc in next 2 ch, 2 sc in last ch; change to B in last st - 2 ripples at the end of this row.

**Row 2:** With B, ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 2 sts, sc3tog, sc in next 2 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts, sc3tog, sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in last st; change to A in last st.

**Row 3:** With A, ch 3 (does not count as a st), turn, 2 dc in first st, dc in next 2 sts, dc3tog, dc in next 2 sts, 3 dc in next st, dc in next 2 sts, dc3tog, dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in last st; change to B in last st.

**Row 4:** With B, rep Row 2; change to C in last st.

**Row 5:** With C, rep Row 3; change to D in last st.

**Row 6:** With D, rep Row 3; change to E in last st.

**Row 7:** With E, rep Row 2; change to D in last st.

**Row 8:** With D, rep Row 2; change to E in last st.

**Row 9:** With E, rep Row 3; change to B in last st.

**Row 10:** With B, rep Row 3; change to F in last st.

**Row 11:** With F, rep Row 3; change to A in last st.

**Row 12:** With A, rep Row 2; change to B in last st.

**Rows 13-56:** Rep Rows 2-12 four more times.

**Rows 57-66:** Rep Rows 2-11 once more.

Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
