MATERIALS

- 864-204 [Lion Brand Vanna's Tapestry: Caribbean](#) 2 Balls **Vanna's Tapestry (Article #864). 100% acrylic; package size: 3.00oz/85.00 gr. (145yds/133m) pull skeins*
- [Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size I-9](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)



GAUGE:

11 dc + 5 rows = about 3 in. (7.5 cm)

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

SCARF

Ch 24.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook (beginning ch counts as first dc), and in each ch across – 22 sts.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, working into front loops only, dc in next st and in each st across – 22 sts.

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, working into back loops only, dc in next st and in each st across. Rep Rows 2 and 3 until piece measures about 60 in. (152.5 cm) from beginning, end with a Row 3 as the last row you work.

Do not fasten off.

FINISHING

Border

Continuing with one st on hook, work sl st evenly spaced around entire outside edge of Scarf, working ch 3 in each corner. Join with sl st in first sl st. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
