**SKILL LEVEL:** Beginner

**SIZE:** One Size

**Finished circumference** About 24 in. (61 cm)

**MATERIALS**

- 640-502 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Mesquite  
2 Balls
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size P-15
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

**GAUGE:**

6 single crochet = about 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

**NOTES:**

1. Cowl is worked in joined rounds. At the end of each round, work a slip stitch to join last stitch to first stitch. Turn at the beginning of each round.
2. If you find it difficult to join the beginning chain into a ring without twisting the chain, Round 1 can be worked as a row then joined into a round, as follows: Chain 37, work a single crochet in 2nd chain from hook, work a single crochet in each remaining chain across; join with slip stitch in first single crochet. Proceed to Round 2. When weaving in ends, use the beginning yarn tail to sew the ends of the first row together.

**COWL**

Chain 37. Being careful not to twist the chain; join with slip stitch in first chain to form a ring.

**Round 1:** Chain 1, work a single crochet in each chain around; join with slip stitch in first single crochet – 36 single crochet stitches at the end of this round.

**Round 2:** Chain 3 (counts as first double crochet), turn, work a double crochet in each single crochet around; join with slip stitch in top of turning chain.

**Round 3:** Chain 1, turn, work a single crochet in each double crochet around; join with slip stitch in first single crochet.

Repeat Rounds 2 and 3 until nearly all yarn has been used. Fasten off.

**FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
