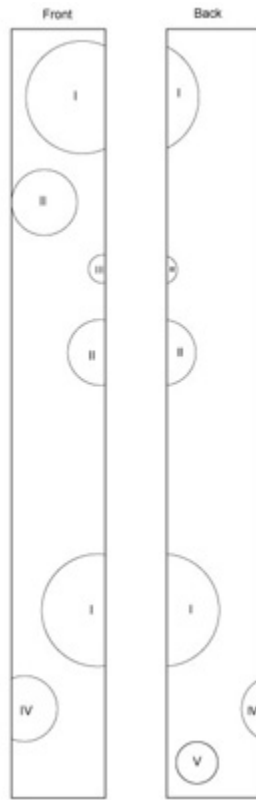

MATERIALS

- 820-153 Lion Brand Lion Wool Yarn: Ebony
6 Balls (A)
- 861-150 Lion Brand Vanna's Glamour: Platinum
2 Balls (B)
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 8 [5 mm]
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size G-6
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size J-10
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

GAUGE:

16 sts + 22 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in Stockinette st (k on RS, p on WS) before felting. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.



SCARF

With A, cast on 44 sts. Work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) until piece measures about 100 in. (254 cm). Bind off.

MOTIF I (make 2)

Note: Motif A is worked with 2 strands of B held tog. With larger hook and 2 strands of B held tog, ch 6; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 12 sc in ring, join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in 1st sc, * ch 4, sl st in 4th ch from hook, ch 4, sk 1 sc, sc in next sc; rep from * 4 times more, ch 4, sl in in 4th ch from hook, ch 3; join with dc in first sc.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in dc, *ch 4, sl st in 4th ch from hook, ch 6, sc in next ch-4 sp; rep from * 4 times more, ch 4, sl in 4th ch from hook, ch 3; join with dc in first sc.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in dc, *ch 4, sl st in 4th ch from hook, ch 7, sc in next ch-6 sp; rep from * 4 times more, ch 4, sl st in 4th ch from hook, ch 4; join with dc in first sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in dc, *ch 7, sc in next ch-7 sp, ch 5, sc in same ch-7 sp; rep from * 4 times more, ch 7, sc in ch-4 sp, ch 2; join with dc in first sc.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, sc in dc, *ch 4, sl st in 4th ch from hook, ch 7, sc in next ch-7 sp, ch 7, sc in next ch-5 sp; rep from * 4 times more, ch 7, sc in ch-7 sp, ch 3; join with tr in first sc.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, sc in tr, *ch 5, sl st in 5th ch from hook, ch 8, sl st in 4th ch from hook, ch 6, sl st in 6th ch from hook, ch 4, sl st in 4th ch from hook, ch 4, sc in next ch-7 sp; rep from * 10 times more, ch 5, sl st in 5th ch from hook, ch 8, sl st in 4th ch from hook, ch 6, sl st in 6th ch from hook, ch 4, sl st in 4th ch from hook, ch 4; join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

MOTIF II (make 2)

With smaller hook, and 1 strand of B, ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 6 sc into ring; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: *Ch 3, sc in next sc; rep from * 4 times more, ch 3; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 3: Sl st in 1st ch of ch-3 sp, ch 3 (counts as first dc), 2 dc in ch-3 sp, *ch 4, sl st in 4th ch from hook, ch 6, 3 dc in next ch-3 sp; rep from * 4 times more, ch 4, sl st in 4th ch from hook, ch 2; join with tr in 3rd ch of ch 3.

Rnd 4: Ch 4 (counts as first dc, ch-1 sp), 2 dc in tr, *ch 12, sl st in 8th ch from hook, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next ch-6 sp; rep from * 4 times more, ch 12, sl st in 8th ch from hook, ch 3, dc in ch-2 sp; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch, ch 1.

Rnd 5: *Sc in next ch-1 sp, (10 tr, ch 3, 10 tr) in next ch-8 sp; rep from * 5 times more; join with sl st in beg sc. Fasten off.

MOTIF III (make 1)

With smaller hook, and 1 strand of B, ch 8, join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 16 sc in ring, join with sl st in top of first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, (sc in sc, ch 5, sk next sc) around; join with sl st in beg sc.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, (sc in sc, 5 sc in ch-5 sp) around, join with sl st in beg sc.

Rnd 4: Sl st around to 3rd sc in first ch-5 sp, ch 1, (sc in 3rd sc of 5-sc group, ch 7, sk next 5 sc) around; join with sl st in beg sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, (sc in sc, 7 sc in ch-7 sp) around; join with sl st in beg sc. Fasten off.

MOTIF IV (make 1)

With smaller hook and 1 strand of B, ch 6, join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 3, 23 dc in ring, join with sl st in beg dc.

Rnd 2: Ch 4, sk first st, *dc in next st, sk next st, ch 2, rep from * around, join with sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 3: Ch 3, 3 tr in next ch-2 sp, * 4 tr in next ch-2 sp, rep from * around, join with sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 4: Ch 3, *(yo and draw up a loop in next st, yo and through 2 loops on hook) 3 times, yo and through 4 loops on hook, ch 5, dc in next st, rep from * around, end with ch 5, join with sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, 3 sc in beg ch-5 sp, (ch 3, sl st in beg ch) (picot made), 4 sc in same ch-5 sp, *4 sc in next ch-5 sp, (ch 3, sl st in beg ch), 4 sc in same ch-5 sp, rep from * around, join with sl st in beg sc. Fasten off.

MOTIF V (make 1)

With smaller hook and 1 strand of B, ch 3, join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 8 sc in ring, join with sl st in beg sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in same sc, ch 1, (2 dc in next sc, ch 1) around; join with sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 3: Sl st across to first ch-1 sp, ch 1, (sc in ch-1 sp, ch 5, skip next 2 dc) around; join with sl st in beg sc.

Rnd 4: Sl st across to 3rd ch of first ch-5 sp, ch 1, (sc in ch-5 sp, ch 7) around, join with sl st in beg sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, *sc in sc, ch 2, (dc in ch-7 sp, ch 2, (tr, ch 2, sl st in tr just made), ch 2, dc) in same ch-5 sp, ch 2; *sc in next sc, ch 2, (dc, ch 2, tr, ch 2, sl st in tr just made, ch 2, dc) in next ch-5 sp, ch 2, rep from * around; join with sl st in beg sc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Felting

Wash Scarf by machine on a hot wash/cold rinse cycle with detergent and several pieces of clothing to agitate. To felt additionally, dry by machine on a regular setting until almost dry. Remove from dryer and pull into shape.

Allow Scarf to dry completely. Following Assembly Diagram, sew Motifs to Scarf.

Note: Some Motifs are folded over edges of Scarf and sewn to both front and back sides of Scarf. Weave in ends.
