# Free Knitting Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

## Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick® Camo Cowl

**SKILL LEVEL:** Beginner (Level 1)

**SIZE:** One Size

### MATERIALS

- 640-508 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Desert](#)  
3 Balls
- [Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 13 \[9 mm\]](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

*\*Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick® (Article #640).*

*Solids, Heathers, Twists: 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool*

*Wheat & Wood: 86% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 4% Rayon*

*Oatmeal & Barley & Grey Marble: 82% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 8% Rayon*

*Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1% Metallic Poly; package size: Solids, Heathers, Twists,*

*Tweeds: 6 oz./170g (106 yd/97 m)*

*Prints (Sequoia, Mesquite, Granite): 5 oz./140g (87 yd/80 m)*

*Metallics: 5 oz./140g (92 yd/84 m)*



### GAUGE:

10 stitches + 16 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in pattern.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

### COWL

Cast on 22 stitches.

**Row 1:** Knit.

**Rows 2-4:** Purl.

**Rows 5-7:** Knit.

Repeat Rows 2-7 until piece measures about 56 in. (142 cm) from beginning.

Bind off.

### FINISHING

Lay piece flat. Turn one of the ends over (180 degree turn) to put a twist in the piece. Keeping the twist, sew ends of piece together to make Cowl.

Weave in ends.
