0-12 months (1-2 years)

Finished Circumference About 15 (17 1/2) in. (38 (44.5) cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

MATERIALS

- 620-099 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease Yarn: Fisherman](#)
1 Ball
- [Lion Brand Double-Pointed Needles - Size 7](#)
- [Lion Brand Double-Pointed Needles - Size 8](#)
- [Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

- *Solid, Heather, Twist: 80% acrylic, 20% wool*
- *Sprinkles, Wheat, Mushroom, Rainbow Mist: 86% acrylic, 10% wool, 4% rayon*
- *Glitter/Multi-colors: 78% acrylic, 19% wool, 3% polyester*
- *Frosts: 70% acrylic, 20% wool, 10% polyamide*
- *Prints: 80% acrylic, 20% wool*

*; package size: **Solid, Heather, Twist:** 3 oz/85g; 197 yd/180m balls*

***Sprinkles, Wheat, Mushroom, Rainbow Mist:** 3 oz/85g; 197 yd/180m balls*

***Glitter/Multi-colors:** 2.5 oz./70g; 162 yd/146m balls*

***Frosts:** 2.5 oz./70g; 162 yd/146m balls*

***Prints:** 2.5 oz/70g; 162 yd/146m balls*



GAUGE:

18 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over St st worked in the rnd (k every rnd) with larger needles.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

PATTERN STITCH

K2, p2 Rib (worked in the rnd over a multiple of 4 sts)

Rnd 1: *K2, p2; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rep Rnd 1 for K2, p2 Rib worked in rnds.

HAT

With smaller needles and A, cast on 76 (88) sts. Divide sts onto 4 needles, with 19 (22) sts on each needle. Place marker for beg of rnd. Join by working the first st on left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist sts.

Rnds 1-8: Work in K2, p2 Rib worked in the rnd.

Change to larger needles and work in St st worked in the rnd (k every rnd) until piece measures about 4 in. (10 cm) from beg.

SIZE 0-12 MONTHS ONLY

Next Rnd: *K17, k2tog, rep from * around - 72 sts at the end of this rnd.

Shape Crown (Top of Hat)

Next (Decrease) Rnd: *K6, k2tog; rep from * around - 63 (77) sts at the end of this rnd.

Next Rnd: Knit.

Next (Decrease) Rnd: *K5, k2tog; rep from * around - 54 (66) sts.

Next Rnd: Knit.

Next (Decrease) Rnd: *K4, k2tog; rep from * around - 45 (55) sts.

Next Rnd: Knit.

Next (Decrease) Rnd: *K3, k2tog; rep from * around - 36 (44) sts.

Next Rnd: Knit.

Next (Decrease) Rnd: *K2, k2tog; rep from * around - 27 (33) sts.

Next Rnd: Knit.

Next (Decrease) Rnd: *K1, k2tog; rep from * around - 18 (22) sts.

Next Rnd: Knit.

Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread tail through sts of the last rnd and pull to gather for top of Hat. Knot securely.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
