## Knit Gift Basket

*Skill Level: Beginner*

### SIZE

9 inches x 9 inches

### MATERIALS

- LION BRAND Lion Cotton
  - 1 ball #153 Black (A)
  - 1 ball #112 Poppy Red (B)or color of your choice
- LION BRAND Size 7 (4.5 mm) knitting needles or size to needed obtain gauge
- Dry Laundry starch (available in the laundry section of most supermarkets)

**Note** This pattern makes several dishcloths. Black cloths are particularly nice for the barbeque chef -- they REALLY don't show the soot!

### GAUGE

20 stitches = 4 inches (10 cm) in pattern. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

### DISHCLOTH

Cast on 46 sts.

**Rows 1 and 2** Knit.

**Rows 3 and 4** Knit 2, \*knit 1, purl 1; repeat from \* across to last 2 stitches, knit 2.

Repeat Rows 1-4 for pattern until piece measures approximately 7 inches from beginning, ending with pattern Row 2. Change to (B), continue in pattern 4 rows

Repeat Rows 1-4 for pattern until piece measures approximately 9 inches from beginning, ending with pattern Row 2. Bind off all stitches in knit.

### FINISHING

1. Mix heavy cooked starch per manufacturer's directions
2. Select a bowl or cooking dish that has the same shape as desired in your basket. This will be the form for your basket.
3. Cover the form with plastic wrap (starch is very sticky and if you omit this step, you will have a very hard time getting your basket off the form)
4. Dip the finished dishcloth in the starch; squeeze to make sure it is completely saturated with starch.
5. Place dishcloth over the form as shown below (if you are using a square pan, the arrangement of the cloth will be different!) Pat into the shape that you want (we folded the corners down to make a rounded shape.)



7. Wait until the basket dries. If it is drying too slowly, bake in a very low temperature oven (200 degrees F.)
8. Remove basket from form.
9. If you plan to fill the basket with something heavy, you may want to cut a piece of cardboard or foam core board the size of the bottom and put it in the bottom of the basket to make it more sturdy.



9. Fill the basket with goodies!
10. If you are filling the basket with something heavy, you may want to wrap it in cellophane to provide better structural strength.
