# Free Knitting Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

## Lion Brand® Heartland

### Lacy & Luscious Scarf

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy

**SIZE:** One Size

About 6 1/2 x 64 in. (16.5 x 162.5 cm)

#### **MATERIALS**

- 136-105 [Lion Brand Heartland Yarn: Glacier Bay](#) 2 Balls
- [Boye Aluminum Circular Knitting Needles 29 inches Size 10](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

*\*Heartland (Article #136). 100% Acrylic; package size: 5.00oz/142.00 gr. (251yds/230m) pull skeins*



#### **GAUGE:**

12 sts + 25 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) over pattern.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### **STITCH EXPLANATION:**

##### **Yo (yarn over)**

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

#### **NOTES:**

1. Scarf is worked lengthwise, in a reversible lace pattern.
2. Because the lace pattern is reversible, rows are not worked on the same side of the piece and there is no right or wrong side.
3. A yarn over (yo) creates a new loop on your needle and is worked by wrapping the yarn around your right hand needle. Do not use an existing st to make a yarn over. The finished yarn over will leave an open space (like an eyelet) in your knitting--that is part of this design.
4. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts. Work back and forth on circular needle as if working on straight needles.

#### **SCARF**

Cast on 188 sts.

**Rows 1-4:** Knit.

**Row 5:** K2, \*yo, k1; rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2 - 372 sts at the end of this row.

**Row 6:** K2, purl across to last 2 sts, k2.

**Row 7:** K2, \*k2tog; rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2 - 188 sts.

**Rows 8 and 9:** K2, \*yo, k2tog; rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

**Rows 10 and 11:** Knit.

**Rows 12-39:** Rep Rows 5-11 four times.

**Rows 40 and 41:** Knit.

Bind off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
