SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference About 20 in. (51 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

MATERIALS

- 640-510 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick: Toucan](#)
1 Ball

- *Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick® (Article #640).
Solids, Heathers, Twists: 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool
Wheat & Wood: 86% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 4% Rayon
Oatmeal & Barley & Grey Marble: 82% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 8% Rayon
Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1% Metallic Poly; package size: Solids, Heathers, Twists, Tweeds: 6 oz./170g (106 yd/97 m)
Prints (Sequoia, Mesquite, Granite): 5 oz./140g (87 yd/80 m)
Metallics: 5 oz./140g (92 yd/84 m)*



GAUGE:

9 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rnds 1-4.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

ssk (slip, slip, knit) Slip next 2 sts as if to knit, one at a time, to right needle; insert left needle into fronts of these 2 sts and knit them tog – 1 st decreased.

NOTES:

Hat is worked in the rnd on double pointed needles.

HAT

With size 13 (9 mm) needles, cast on 48 sts. Divide sts onto 4 needles, with 12 sts on each needle. Place marker for beg of rnd. Join by working the first st on left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist sts.

Rnds 1, 2, and 4: *P2, k4; rep from * around.

Rnd 3: *P2, sl 2 sts to cable needle and hold in front of work, k2, then k2 from cable needle; rep from * around.

Rep Rnds 1-4 until piece measures about 7 in. (18 cm) from beg, end with a Rnd 2 as your last rnd.

Shape Crown (Top of Hat)

Decrease Rnd: *P2, sl 2 sts to cable needle and hold in front of work, k2tog, k2 from cable needle; rep from * around – 40 sts at the end of this rnd.

Next Rnd: *P2, k3; rep from * around.

Dec Rnd: *P2, sl 2 sts to cable needle and hold in front of work, k1, ssk from cable needle; rep from * around – 32 sts.

Next Rnd: *P2, k2; rep from * around.

Dec Rnd: *P2tog, sl 1 st to cable needle and hold in front of work, k1, k1 from cable needle; rep from * around – 24 sts.

Next Rnd: *P1, k2; rep from * around.

Dec Rnd: *P1, ssk; rep from * around – 16 sts.

Next Rnd: *P1, k1; rep from * around.

Dec Rnd: *K2tog; rep from * around – 8 sts.

Knit one rnd.

Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail into blunt needle and then through remaining sts, pull to gather. Knot securely.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
