# Free Knitting Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

## Lion Brand® Amazing® Port Chester Cowl

Pattern Number: 90582B

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy +

**SIZE:** One Size

**Finished Circumference** About 44 in. (112 cm)

**Finished Height** About 13 (33 cm)

### MATERIALS

- 825-208 Lion Brand Amazing™ Yarn: Glacier Bay  
4 Balls
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials  
Circular knitting needle size 10 1/2 (6.5 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long

### GAUGE:

12 sts = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st worked in the rnd (k every rnd) with 2 strands of yarn held tog. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

### STITCH EXPLANATION:

#### PATTERN STITCH

**K2, p2 Rib (worked in the rnd, multiple of 4 sts)**

**Rnd 1:** \*K2, p2, rep from \* around.

Rep Rnd 1 for K2, p2 Rib.

### NOTES:

Cowl is worked with 2 strands of yarn held tog throughout.

### COWL

With 2 strands of yarn held tog, cast on 132 sts. Join, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker for beg of rnd.

Work in K2, p2 Rib for 1 1/2 in. (4 cm).

Change to St st worked in the rnd (k every rnd) and work until piece measures about 11 1/2 in. (29 cm) from beg.

Work in K2, p2 Rib for 1 1/2 in. (4 cm).

Bind off.

### FINISHING

Weave in ends.
