**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy

**SIZE:** One Size

**Finished Circumference** About 18 in. (45.5 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

#### MATERIALS

- 135-400 [Lion Brand Hometown USATM Yarn: Neon Pink](#)  
1 Ball (A)
- 135-099 [Lion Brand Hometown USATM Yarn: Los Angeles Tan](#)  
1 Ball (B)
- [Brittany Birchwood Double Pointed Needles - Size 13](#)
- [Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

*\*Hometown USA® (Article #135). **Solids and Multis:** 100% Acrylic  
**Tweeds:** 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 5 oz. (140 g), 81 yd. (74 m)  
**Multis and Tweeds:** 4 oz. (113 g), 64 yd. (59 m)*



#### GAUGE:

9 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st worked in the rnd (k every rnd).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### NOTES:

1. Hat is worked in rnds, beg at the lower edge.
2. Do not cut yarn between color changes; simply carry the unused color along the wrong side of your work.
3. Slipping the first st on Rnds 8 and 10 will help to prevent a 'jog' when changing color.

#### HAT

With A, loosely cast on 40 sts. Divide sts onto 4 needles, with 10 sts on each needle. Place marker for beg of rnd. Join by working the first st on left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist sts.

**Rnd 1:** \*K2, p2; rep from \* to end of rnd.

Change to B.

**Rnds 2-5:** With B, rep Rnd 1 four times.

Change to St st worked in the rnd (k every rnd).

**Rnd 6:** With B, k to end of rnd.

**Rnd 7:** With A, k to end of rnd.

**Rnd 8:** Slip first st, then with A, k to end of rnd.

**Rnd 9:** With B, k to end of rnd.

**Rnd 10:** Slip first st, then with B, k to end of rnd.

**Rnds 11-13:** With B, knit.



Repeat Rnds 7-13 twice more.

Cut A.

**Next Rnd:** With B, \*k2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd - 20 sts remain.

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through remaining sts and pull to gather. Knot securely.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
