## Lion Brand® Quick & Cozy

### Very Berry Hat

Pattern Number: L0497

**SKILL LEVEL:** [Easy](#)

**SIZE:** One Size

**Finished Circumference** About 19 in. (48.5 cm)

**Finished Height** About 8 in. (20.5 cm)

**Note:** Hat will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

#### MATERIALS

- 926-112 [Lion Brand Quick & Cozy Yarn: Raspberry](#)  
1 Ball
- [Lion Brand Knitting Needles - Size 13 \[9 mm\]](#)
- [Pom pom Maker](#)
- [Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

#### GAUGE:

7 sts + 12 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### NOTES:

1. Hat is worked back and forth in rows, from lower edge to top (crown).
2. The crown is shaped and gathered, then Hat is seamed.

#### HAT

Cast on 34 sts.

Knit 2 rows.

Beg with a RS (knit) row, work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) until piece measures 5 1/2 in. (14 cm) from beg, end with a WS row. **Note:**

End with a WS row means that the last row you work should be a WS row, and the next row that you are ready to work will be a RS row.

#### Crown

**Next Row (RS):** \*K3, k2tog, k2, k2tog; rep from \* to last 7 sts, k3, k2tog, k2 - 27 sts at the end of this row.

**Next Row:** Purl.

**Next Row:** \*K2, k2tog, k1, k2tog; rep from \* to last 6 sts, k2, k2tog, k2 - 20 sts at the end of this row.

**Next Row:** Purl.

**Next Row:** \*K1, (k2tog) twice; rep from \* to end of row - 12 sts.

**Next Row:** Purl.

**Next Row:** (K2tog) 6 times - 6 sts.

**Next Row:** Purl.

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through remaining sts, pull to gather, and knot securely.

#### FINISHING

Seam Hat. If desired, use sewing thread to seam.

Following package directions, make a medium size pom-pom.

Tie pom-pom to top of Hat. Weave in ends.
