**Finished Circumference** About 44 in. (112 cm) at widest point

## MATERIALS

- 480-206 [Lion Brand Nature's Choice Organic Cotton Yarn: Wildflowers](#)  
6 Balls
- [Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size H-8](#)
- [Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

## GAUGE:

Rnds 1-8 = 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

## NOTES:

1. Bag is worked in rnds. At the end of each rnd, join with sl st in first st. Do not turn at the beg of rnds.
2. Handles are worked separately and sewn to top of Bag.

## BAG

Beg at bottom of bag, ch 2.

**Rnd 1 (RS):** Work 6 sc in first ch; join with sl st in first sc - 6 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, 2 sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc - 12 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, \*sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc - 18 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 1, \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc - 24 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 5:** Ch 1, \*sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc - 30 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 6:** Ch 1, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around to last 3 sc, sc in last 3 sc; join with sl st in first sc - 36 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 7:** Ch 1, \*sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc - 42 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 8:** Ch 1, sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around to last 4 sc, sc in last 4 sc; join with sl st in first sc - 48 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 9:** Ch 1, \*sc in next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc - 54 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 10:** Ch 1, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around to last 5 sc, sc in last 5 sc; join with sl st in first sc - 60 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 11:** Ch 1, \*sc in next 9 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc - 66 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 12:** Ch 1, sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 10 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around to last 6 sc, sc in last 6 sc; join with sl st in first sc - 72 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 13:** Ch 1, \*sc in next 11 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc - 78 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 14:** Ch 1, sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 12 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around to last 7 sc, sc in last 7 sc; join with sl st in first sc - 84 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 15:** Ch 1, \*sc in next 13 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc - 90 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 16:** Ch 1, sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 14 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around to last 8 sc, sc in last 8 sc; join with sl st in first sc - 96 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 17:** Ch 1, \*sc in next 15 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc - 102 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 18:** Ch 1, sc in next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 16 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around to last 9 sc, sc in last 9 sc; join with sl st in first sc - 108 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 19:** Ch 1, \*sc in next 17 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc - 114 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnds 20-22:** Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnd 23:** Ch 1, sc in next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 18 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around to last 10 sc, sc in last 10 sc; join with sl st in first sc - 120 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnds 24-26:** Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnd 27:** Ch 1, \*sc in next 19 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc - 126 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnds 28-30:** Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnd 31:** Ch 1, sc in next 9 sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 20 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around to last 11 sc, sc in last 11 sc; join with sl st in first sc - 132 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnds 32-34:** Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnd 35:** Ch 1, \*sc in next 21 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc - 138 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnds 36-38:** Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnd 39:** Ch 1, sc in next 10 sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 22 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around to last 12 sc, sc in last 12 sc; join

with sl st in first sc - 144 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnds 40-42:** Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnd 43:** Ch 1, \*sc in next 23 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc - 150 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnds 44-46:** Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnd 47:** Ch 1, sc in next 11 sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 24 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around to last 13 sc, sc in last 13 sc; join with sl st in first sc - 156 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnds 48-50:** Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnd 51:** Ch 1, \*sc in next 25 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc - 162 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnds 52-54:** Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnd 55:** Ch 1, sc in next 12 sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 26 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around to last 14 sc, sc in last 14 sc; join with sl st in first sc - 168 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnds 56-58:** Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnd 59:** Ch 1, \*sc in next 27 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc - 174 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnds 60 and 61:** Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

### HANDLES (make 2)

Leaving a long beg tail, ch 65.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across - 64 sc at the end of this row.

**Rows 2-4:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

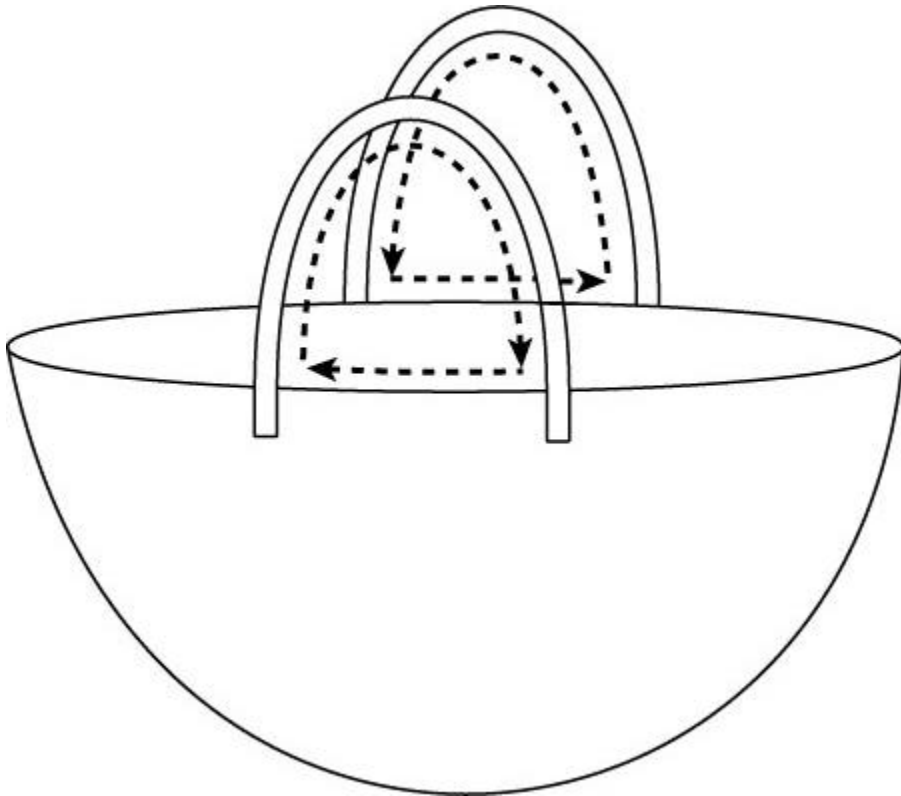
Fasten off. Cut yarn, leaving a long tail.

### FINISHING

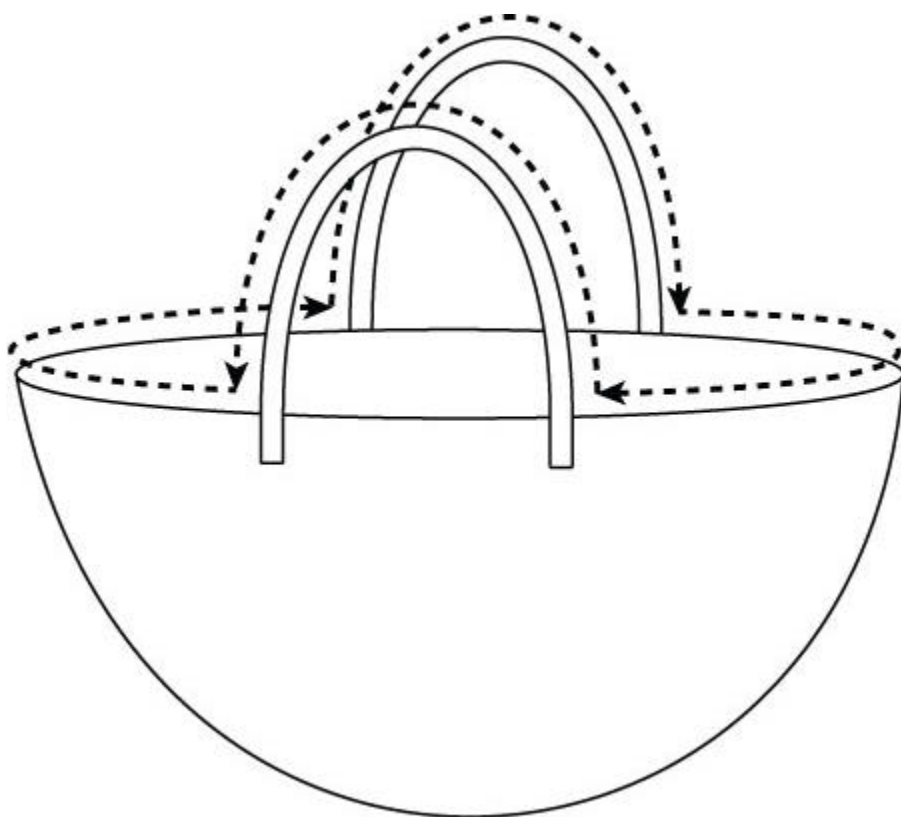
With yarn tails, sew ends of Handles to top of Bag.

#### Edging

**Note:** Edging is worked in 3 separate sections around Bag, following diagram.



From RS, join yarn with sl st at inside corner of one handle. Ch 1, sc evenly along inner edge of Handle and along top edge of Bag between Handle ends. Join with a sl st in first sc. Fasten off. Rep on opposite Handle.



From RS, join yarn with sl st anywhere along top edge of Bag. Ch 1, sc evenly around top edge of Bag and along outer edge of Handles. Join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.
