SKILL LEVEL - Easy

SIZE

About 35 x 46 in. (89 x 117 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Heartland® (Art. #136)
 - 098 Arcadia 3 balls (A)
 - 109 Olympic 1 ball (B)
 - 105 Glacier Bay 1 ball (C)
 - 173 Everglades 1 ball (D)
 - 158 Yellowstone 1 ball (E)
 - 125 Mammoth Cave 1 ball (F)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size I-9 (5.5mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

One square = about 5 3/4 x 5 3/4 in. (14.5 x 14.5 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

rev sc (reverse single crochet) Single crochet worked from left to right (right to left, if left-handed). Insert hook into next stitch to the right (left), under loop on hook, and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all loops on hook.

NOTES

1. Afghan is made from 48 Squares sewn tog following Assembly Diagram.
2. Each Square is worked in joined rnds with RS always facing. The last 2 rnds of each Square are worked with A.
3. Border is worked around the entire outer edge of the assembled Afghan.

AFGHAN

Make 48 Squares as follows:

- 10 with B as first color
- 10 with D as first color
- 10 with F as first color
- 9 with C as first color
- 9 with E as first color

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Square

With first color (noted above), make an adjustable ring as follows:

Wrap yarn around index finger. Insert hook into ring on finger, yarn over and draw up a loop. Carefully slip ring from finger and work the stitches of Rnd 1 (in pattern, below) into the ring. When Rnd 1 is complete, gently but firmly, pull yarn tail to tighten center of ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), work 11 dc into ring, join with sl st in top of beg ch – 12 sts.

Rnd 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in same sp, work 2 dc in each st around; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 24 sts at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 3: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), work 2 dc in next st, * dc in next st, 2 dc in next st; rep from * around, join with sl st in top of beg ch – 36 sts.

Rnd 4: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, *dc in each of next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st; rep from * around, join with sl st in top of beg ch – 48 sts.

Fasten off first color.

Rnd 5: Join A with sl st in any st of Rnd 4. Ch 6 (counts as tr, ch 2), tr in same st, * 2 dc in next st, dc in next st, hdc in next st, sc in each of next 5 sts, hdc in next st, dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, (tr, ch2, tr) in next st; rep from * twice more; 2 dc in next st, dc in next st, hdc in next st, sc in each of next 5 sts, hdc in next st, dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, join with sl st in 4th ch of beg ch-6 – at the end of this rnd you will have 60 sts and 4 ch-2 sps.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, * 3 sc in ch-2sp, sc in each st to next ch-2sp; rep from * around, join with sl st in first sc – 72sts.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Following diagram, sew squares into 6 strips of 8 Squares each. Sew strips together to make Afghan.

Border

Rnd 1: From RS, join A with sl st in center sc of any corner sc group. Ch 3 (counts as first dc), work 2 dc in same st; dc in each st around, working 3 dc in each corner, join with sl st in top of beg ch-3.

Fasten off.

Note: To change to F on Rnd 2, work last st of B to last yarn over. Yarn over with F and draw through all loops on hook to complete the st.

Rnd 2: From RS, join B with sl st in center dc at any corner. Ch 1, work rev sc (single crochet worked from left to right) in every st to next corner, then continue in rev sc to next corner, changing to F in last st; with F continue in rev sc around remaining edges of Afghan, join with sl st in first st.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

hdc = half double crochet
rep = repeat

sc = single crochet
sk = skip
sl st = slip stitch
st(s) = stitch(es)
tr = triple (treble) crochet
