\*<u>Vanna's Glamour</u> (Article #861). 96% Acrylic, 4% Metallic Polyester; package size: 1.75oz/49.61 gr. (202yds/185m) pull skeins

Acrylic: 100% Acrylic. Care: Machine Wash and Dry, Do Not Bleach, Do Not Iron, Tumble Dry Normal, Dry Clean and Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.

**Metallic:** 96% Acrylic, 4% Metallic Polyester. **Care:** Machine Wash Cool, Lay Flat to Dry, Do Not Bleach,

Do Not Iron, Dry Clean Any Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.; package size: **Cotton:** Weight

13 hdc = about 4 in. (10 cm) with larger hook and A or B.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

# TECHNIQUE EXPLANATION Adjustable Ring Method

Wrap yarn around index finger. Insert hook into ring on finger, yarn over and draw up a loop. Carefully slip ring from finger and work the stitches of Rnd 1 (in pattern, below) into the ring. When Rnd 1 is complete, gently but firmly, pull tail to tighten center of ring.

#### STITCH EXPLANATION

dc2tog (dc 2 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook - 1 st decreased.

#### NOTES:

Each Cozy is crocheted in your choice of A or B, then trimmed with embellishments made with C and D yarns.

#### COZY

With larger hook and A or B, ch 30, join with a sl st in beg ch to make a ring, being careful not to twist the ch.

Rnd 1: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), hdc in each ch around, join with sl st in top of beg ch-2 - 30 hdc.

Rnd 2: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), hdc in each st around, join with sl st in top of beg ch-2.

Rep Rnd 2 until piece measures about 3 in. (7.5 cm).

Fasten off.

# **EMBELLISHMENTS**

Make as many embellishments as you like in your choice of colors!

#### Balloon

With smaller hook and C or D in your choice of color, make an adjustable ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 3, work 10 dc in ring; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3.

Rnd 2: Ch 3, dc in same sp as joining, ch 2, sl st in same sp.

Fasten off leaving a long yarn tail.

Wrap yarn tail around base of Rnd 2 and knot.

With yarn tail, sew balloon to Cozy, making a long straight st for balloon 'string'.

### **Fireworks**

With C or D in your choice of color, embroider long straight sts onto Cozy.

#### **Party Hat**

With smaller hook and C or D in your choice of color, ch 12.

Row 1: Dc in 3rd ch from hook (beg ch does not count as a st) and in each ch across – 10 sts.

Row 2: Ch 3 (does not count as a st), turn, dc2tog, dc in each st to last 2 sts, dc2tog - 8 sts.

Rep Row 2 until 2 sts remain, dc2tog.

SI st around outside of Hat, join with sI st in beg sI st.

Fasten off.

# **Lower Edging**

Join a second C or D color of your choice at one corner of lower straight edge of Hat. Ch 3, sl st in same sp as joining; \*ch 3, sl st in next st; rep from \* across straight edge. Fasten off.

Tie a few strands of C or D color of your choice with another strand of yarn at center, trim and fringe ends to make a little pompom.

Sew pompom to top of Hat. Sew Hat to Cozy.

#### Numbers 2 and 5

With smaller hook and C or D color of your choice, ch 18.

**Row 1:** SI st in second ch from hook and in each ch across.

Fasten off leaving a long yarn tail.

Shape strip into a 2 or a 5 and with long yarn tail, sew onto Cozy.

#### Number 0

With smaller hook and C or D color of your choice, ch 12.

Join with a sl st in first ch to make a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, work 18 sc into ring; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off leaving a long yarn tail.

With yarn tail, sew onto Cozy.

## Number 1

With smaller hook and C or D color of your choice, ch 9.

**Row 1:** Sc into second ch from hook and in each ch across.

Fasten off leaving a long yarn tail.

With yarn tail, sew onto Cozy.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
