## Lion Brand® Vanna's Choice® - Bonbons Tween Dream Scarf

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy (Level 2)

**SIZE:** One Size

About 8 1/2 x 40 in. (21.5 x 101.5 cm), before fringe

**400, 401, 403:** 92% Acrylic, 8% Rayon

**402:** 96% Acrylic, 4% Rayon; package size:

**Solids:** 3.5 oz (100 g), 170 yards (156 m)

**Prints, Tweeds, & Heathers:** 3 ozs (85 g) , 145 yards (133 meters)

**Twists:** 2.5 oz (70 g), 121 yards (111 meters)

*\*Bonbons (Article #601).*

**Cotton:** 100% Cotton. **Care:** Machine Wash Cool, Gentle Cycle, Do Not Bleach, Dry Flat, Low Iron, Dry Clean Any Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.

**Acrylic:** 100% Acrylic. **Care:** Machine Wash and Dry, Do Not Bleach, Do Not Iron, Tumble Dry Normal, Dry Clean and Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.

**Metallic:** 96% Acrylic, 4% Metallic Polyester. **Care:** Machine Wash Cool, Lay Flat to Dry, Do Not Bleach, Do Not Iron, Dry Clean Any Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.; package size: **Cotton:** Weight Category 2: Sport Weight

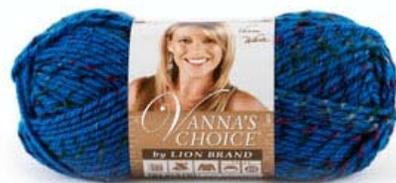

### MATERIALS

- 860-099 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Linen  
1 Ball (A)
- 601-610 Lion Brand Bonbons Yarn: Brights  
1 Ball (B)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



### GAUGE:

5 V-sts + 7 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern

and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

### Making a Gauge Swatch

#### **STITCH EXPLANATION:**

**V-st** (Dc, ch 1, dc) in indicated ch or sp.

#### **NOTES:**

1. Scarf is worked back in forth in rows, changing yarn color to make stripes.
2. Stripes are worked with 2 strands of B yarn held together. Have fun and choose whatever colors you'd like!
3. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops to complete the st. Fasten off old color. Proceed with new color.

#### **SCARF**

With one strand of A, ch 34.

**Row 1:** V-st in 5th ch from hook (first 4 ch count as dc + 1 skipped ch), \*sk 2 ch, V-st in next ch; rep from \* to last 2 ch, sk next ch, dc in last ch – at the end of Row 1 you will have 10 V-sts with 1 dc at each end.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, \*V-st in ch-1 sp of V-st; rep from \* across, dc in top of beg ch. Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 28 in. (71 cm) from beg.

Change to any 2 colors of B.

Rep Row 2 for 7 rows.

Change to any 2 colors of B.

Rep Row 2 for 7 rows.

Change to any 2 colors of B.

Rep Row 2 for 7 rows.

Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

Cut five 12 in. (30.5 cm) long strands of any B yarn. Hold strands together and fold in half. Use hook to draw fold through edge of Scarf, forming a loop. Pull ends of fringe through this loop. Pull to tighten. Make 11 fringes along each short end of Scarf. Trim fringe ends evenly.

Weave in ends.
