## **SKILL LEVEL – Easy**

### **SIZES**

#### **Headband**

**Finished Circumference** About 18 in. (45.5 cm),  
will stretch to fit a range of sizes

**Finished Width** About 4 1/2 in. (11.5 cm)

#### **Gloves**

**Finished Circumference** About 7 1/2 in. (19 cm)

**Finished Length** About 9 1/2 in. (24 cm)

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® LB Collection® Angora Merino (Art. #491)
  - 152 Pewter 1 ball (A)
  - 150 Smoked Pearl 1 ball (B)
  - 108 Blue Bonnet 1 ball (C)
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 6 (4.25 mm)
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 7 (4.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



### **GAUGE**

20 sts + 30 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Slip Stitch pattern with larger needles.  
**BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**

### **PATTERN STITCHES**

**K1, p1 Rib (worked over a multiple of 2 sts + 1 additional st)**

**Row 1:** K1, \*p1, k1; rep from \* to end of row.

**Row 2:** K the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 for K1, p1 Rib.

**Slip Stitch Pattern (worked over a multiple of 4 sts + 3 additional sts)**

**Row 1 (RS):** With A, knit.

**Row 2:** With A, purl.

**Row 3:** With B, k3, \*sl 1 wyib, k3: rep from \* across.

**Row 4:** With B, p3, \*sl 1 wyif, p3: rep from \* across.

**Row 5:** With C, k1, \*sl 1 wyib, k3: rep from \* to last 2 sts, sl 1 wyib, k1.

**Row 6:** With C, k1, \*sl 1 wyif, k3: rep from \* to last 2 sts, sl 1 wyif, k1.

**Rows 7 and 8:** With B, rep Rows 3 and 4.

**Row 9:** With A, rep Row 5.

**Row 10:** With A, p1, \*sl 1 wyif, p3: rep from \* to last 2 sts, sl 1 wyif, p1.

Rep Rows 1-10 for Slip st pattern.

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## **NOTES**

1. Headband and Gloves are worked in a slip st pattern. Do not cut yarn colors between color changes, just carry unused color(s) alongside edge of work.
2. Headband is worked back and forth in one piece, then ends are sewed together to make a loop.
3. Gloves are seamed, leaving an opening for thumb.

## **HEADBAND**

With smaller needles and A, cast on 91 sts.  
Work in K1, p1 Rib for 6 rows.

Change to larger needles and beg with Row 1, work in Slip st pattern.  
Continue in Slip st pattern until Row 10 has been completed, then rep Rows 1-10 again, then rep Rows 1 and 2 once more – 22 rows of Slip st pattern worked.

Change to smaller needles and with A only, work in K1, p1 Rib for 6 rows.  
Bind off.  
Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

## **FINISHING**

With yarn tail, sew ends of piece together to make Headband.  
Weave in ends.

## **GLOVES (make 2)**

With smaller needles and A, cast on 39 sts.  
Work in K1, p1 Rib for 6 rows.

Change to larger needles and beg with Row 1, work in Slip st pattern.  
Continue in Slip st pattern until Row 10 has been completed, then rep Rows 1-10 five more times, then rep Rows 1 and 2 once more – 62 rows of Slip st pattern worked.

Change to smaller needles and with A only, work in K1, p1 Rib for 6 rows.  
Bind off.  
Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

## **FINISHING**

Beginning at bound off end, sew sides of Glove together for 1 in. (2.5 cm).  
Leave next 1 1/2 in. (4 cm) unsewn for thumb opening, then sew remaining sides closed.

Rep with 2nd Glove.

Weave in ends.

**ABBREVIATIONS**

beg = begin(s)(ning)

k = knit

p = purl

rep = repeat(s)(ing)

st(s) = stitch(es)

wyib = with yarn in back

wyif = with yarn in front
