**Lion Brand® Shawl In A Ball**  
**Selene Colorblock Super Scarf**  
**Pattern Number: L60220**



## **SKILL LEVEL - Easy**

### **SIZE**

About 10 x 100 in. (25.5 x 254 cm)

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Shawl In A Ball (Art. #828)
  - 204 Healing Teal 1 ball (A)
  - 207 Feng Shui Grey 1 ball (B)
  - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size I-9 (5.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



### **GAUGE**

3 pattern reps = about 5 in. (12.5 cm).

**Note:** One pattern rep consists of (ch 3, sc) twice in odd-numbered rows and (ch 3, 3 dc, ch 3, sc) in even-numbered rows.

**BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**

### **NOTES**

1. Scarf is worked in one piece, back and forth in rows.
2. The yarn color is changed to make blocks of color.
3. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.
4. For those who find a visual helpful, we've included a stitch diagram.

### **SCARF**

With A, ch 50.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, ch 1, sk next ch, sc in next ch, \*ch 3, sk next 3 ch, sc in next ch; rep from \* to last 2 ch, ch 1, sk next ch, sc in last ch – you will have 14 sc, 11 ch-3 sps, and 2 ch-1 sps in this row (for 6 pattern reps).

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in first ch-1 sp, ch 3, sc in first ch-3 sp, \*ch 3, 3 dc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* to last ch-1 sp, ch 3, dc in last ch-1 sp, dc in last st – Five 3-dc groups, 6 sc, 12 ch-3 sps, and 2 dc at beg and end of row.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, ch 1, sc in first ch-3 sp, ch 3, sk next sc, sc in next ch-3 sp, \*ch 3, sk next 3-dc group, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, sk next sc, sc in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* to last 2 dc, ch 1, sk next dc, sc in top of beg ch.

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**Row 4:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, ch 3, sk first ch-1 sp, 3 dc in first ch-3 sp, \*ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, 3 dc in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* to last ch-1 sp, ch 3, sk last ch-1 sp, sc in last st – Six 3-dc groups, 7 sc, and 12 ch-3 sps.

**Row 5:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, sc in first ch-3 sp, ch 3, sk next 3-dc group, sc in next ch-3 sp, \*ch 3, sk next sc, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, sk next 3-dc group, sc in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* to last sc, ch 1, dc in last sc – 12 sc, 2 dc, 11 ch-3 sps, and 2 ch-1 sps.

Rep Rows 2-5 and change color as follows: Work 52 more rows with A (for a total of 57 rows worked with A), 56 rows with B, 56 rows with A, and 56 rows with B. Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

sc = single crochet

sk = skip

st(s) = stitch(es)

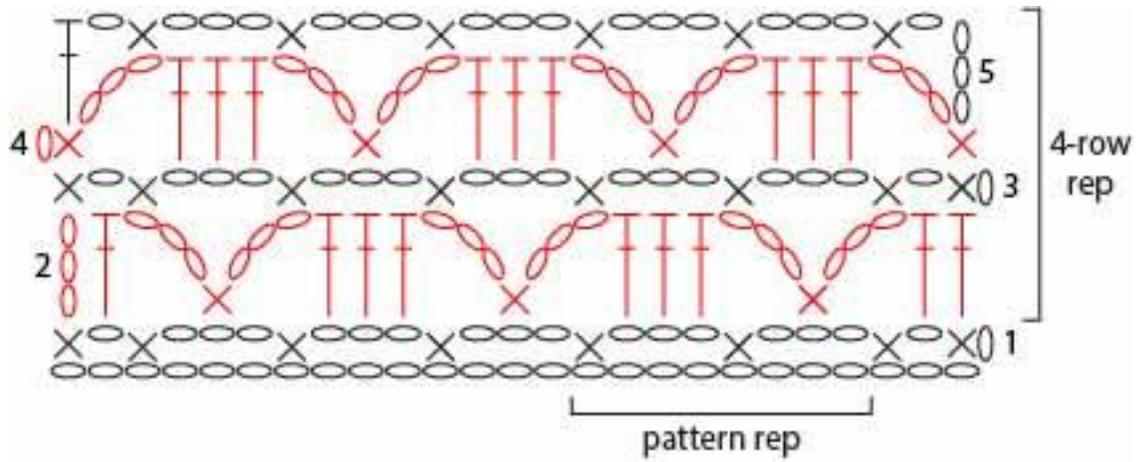
