## **SKILL LEVEL** – Intermediate

### **SIZES**

#### **S/M (L/1X)**

**Finished Waist** About 32 (36) in. (81.5 (91.5) cm)

**Finished Length** About 23 1/2 (23 1/2) in. (59.5 (59.5) cm)

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger size in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to both sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Jeans (Art. #505)
  - 105 Faded 1 (2) ball(s) (A)
  - 109 Stonewash 1 (2) ball(s) (B)
  - 110 Classic 1 (1) ball (C)
  - 150 Vintage 2 (3) balls (D)
  - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



### **GAUGE**

1 Large Granny Square = about 4 x 4 in. (10 x 10 cm).

**BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**

### **NOTES**

1. Skirt is made from 5 pieces: Back, Front, 2 Side Panels, and Flounce.
2. Back and Front are each made from 9 Large Granny Squares and 36 Small Granny Squares.
3. The Large Granny Squares are arranged following a Layout Diagram then Small Granny Squares are worked and crocheted to previous Squares to join all Squares together without sewing.
4. Back, Front and Side Panels are crocheted together then waistband is worked around top edge and flounce is worked around lower edge of Skirt.
5. Squares are worked in joined and turned rnds, beg with a WS rnd. Yarn is fastened off at end of each rnd the piece is then turned and new yarn color is joined at beg of next rnd.
6. For those who find visuals helpful, we've included stitch diagrams.

### **LARGE GRANNY SQUARE I (make 10)**

With A, ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to make a ring.

**Rnd 1 (WS):** Ch 3 (counts as dc), work 15 dc in ring; join with sl st in top of beg ch – you will have 16 dc in this rnd.

Fasten off.

**Rnd 2 (RS):** From RS, draw up a loop of B in any st, ch 3 (counts as dc), (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same st (first corner made), \*sk next 3 sts, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next

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st (corner made); rep from \* 2 more times, sk last 3 sts; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Eight 3-dc groups and 4 corner ch-2 sps.

Fasten off.

**Rnd 3 (WS):** From WS, draw up a loop of C in any corner ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp, \*3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Twelve 3-dc groups and 4 corner ch-2 sps (three 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides between corner ch-2 sps).

Fasten off.

**Rnd 4 (RS):** From RS, draw up a loop of D in any corner ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp, \*(ch 1, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups) twice, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, (ch 1, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups) twice, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Sixteen 3-dc groups, 12 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-2 sps, (four 3-dc groups and 3 ch-1 sps along each of 4 sides between corner ch-2 sps).

Fasten off.

### **LARGE GRANNY SQUARE II (make 8)**

Make same as Large Granny Square I using A for beg ring and Rnd 1, C for Rnd 2, B for Rnd 3, and D for Rnd 4.

### **FRONT**

Arrange 5 Large Granny Square I and 4 Large Granny Square II, with RS facing up, following Layout Diagram.

### **Small Granny Squares (make and join 36)**

#### **Notes:**

1. Follow Layout Diagram for placement of each Small Granny Square.
2. Work Rnd 1 with D. Then work Rnd 2 using the yarn color indicated on Layout Diagram.
3. Small Granny Squares are joined to previous Squares as Rnd 2 is worked.
4. Hold the current Small Granny Square in the location shown in Layout Diagram. Identify the neighboring Squares to which the current Small Granny Square needs to be joined.
5. Begin Rnd 2 by following the "Beg Corner and Following Side" instructions that appear below Rnd 2. When instructed to "work Corner" select and follow the appropriate instructions. If the corner and following side need to be joined to a neighbor, follow the "Join Corner and Following Side" instructions. If the corner needs to be joined to a neighbor but the following side does not need to be joined, follow the "Join Corner Only" instructions. If the corner does not need to be joined to a neighbor, follow the "Unjoined Corner" instructions.

With D, ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to make a ring.

**Rnd 1 (WS):** Ch 3 (counts as dc), work 15 dc in ring; join with sl st in top of beg ch – you will have 16 dc in this rnd.

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Fasten off.

**Rnd 2 (RS):** From RS, draw up a loop of yarn color indicated in Layout Diagram in any st, work Join Beg Corner and Following Side, [sk next 3 sts, work Corner] 3 times; join with sl st in top of beg ch.

**Join Beg Corner and Following Side:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same st as joining, ch 1, sl st in corner ch-sp of neighboring Square, 2 dc in same st, yarn over, insert hook in same st, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops rem on hook), insert hook in next sp of neighboring Square, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook (3rd dc of corner and joining sl st completed).

**Join Corner and Following Side:** 3 dc in next st, ch 1, sl st in next sp of neighboring Square, 2 dc in st, yarn over, insert hook in same st, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops rem on hook), insert hook in next sp of neighboring Square, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook (3rd dc of corner and joining sl st completed).

**Join Corner Only:** 3 dc in next corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, sl st in next sp of neighboring Square, 3 dc in same corner ch-2 sp.

**Unjoined Corner:** (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next st.

### Right Side Panel

**Note:** When instructed to work or join in a "sp", work or join into the next ch-1 sp, ch-3 sp, sp between 3-st groups, or sp between Squares.

### Size S/M Only

**Row 1 (RS):** From RS, join B with sc in 10th sp below top right corner (this is the sp between the 3rd and 4th Squares from the top), \*ch 3, sc in next sp; rep from \* 7 more times to lower edge – 9 sc and 8 ch-3 sps.

**Row 2:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, 3 dc in first ch-3 sp, (ch 1, sk next sc, 3 dc in next ch-3 sp) 3 times, (ch 1, sk next sc, 3 hdc in next ch-3 sp) twice, (ch 1, sk next sc, 3 sc in next ch-3 sp) twice, ch 1, sl st in first sc – Eight 3-st groups and 9 ch-1 sps.

Fasten off.

**Row 3:** From RS, join C with sc in 4th sp below top corner, \*ch 3, sc in next sp; rep from \* 13 more times to lower edge – 15 sc and 14 ch-3 sps.

**Row 4:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, 3 dc in first ch-3 sp, (ch 1, sk next sc, 3 dc in next ch-3 sp) 8 times, (ch 1, sk next sc, 3 hdc in next ch-3 sp) 3 times, (ch 1, sk next sc, 3 sc in next ch-3 sp) twice, ch 1, sl st in first sc – Fourteen 3-st groups and 15 ch-1 sps.

Fasten off.

**Row 5:** From RS, join C with sc in 2nd sp below top corner, \*ch 3, sc in next sp; rep from \* 15 more times to lower edge – 17 sc and 16 ch-3 sps.

**Row 6:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, 3 dc in first ch-3 sp, (ch 1, sk next sc, 3 dc in next ch-3 sp) 10 times, (ch 1, sk next sc, 3 hdc in next ch-3 sp) 3 times, (ch 1, sk next sc, 3 sc in next ch-3 sp) twice, ch 1, sl st in last sc – Sixteen 3-st groups and 17 ch-1 sps.

Fasten off.

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### **Size L/1X Only**

**Row 1 (RS):** From RS, join B with sc in top right corner ch-2 sp, \*ch 3, sc in next sp; rep from \* all the way along right edge working last sc in lower right corner ch-2 sp – 19 sc and 18 ch-3 sps.

**Row 2:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, 3 dc in first ch-3 sp, \*ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* across, dc in last sc – Eighteen 3-dc groups and 18 ch-1 sps. Fasten off.

**Row 3:** From RS, join B with sc in 10th sp below top edge, \*ch 3, sc in next sp; rep from \* 7 more times to lower edge – 9 sc and 8 ch-3 sps.

**Rows 4-8:** Work same as Rows 2-6 of "Right Side Panel - Size S/M Only" instructions (above).  
Fasten off.

### **Left Side Panel**

**Note:** To change yarn color at the end of a row, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.

### **Size S/M Only**

**Row 1 (RS):** From RS, join B with sc in lower left corner ch-2 sp, \*ch 3, sc in next sp; rep from \* 7 more times – 9 sc and 8 ch-3 sps.

**Row 2:** Ch 1 (counts as ch-1 sp), turn, 3 sc in first ch-3 sp, ch 1, sk next sc, 3 sc in next ch-3 sp, (ch 1, sk next sc, 3 hdc in next ch-3 sp) twice, (ch 1, sk next sc, 3 dc in next ch-3 sp) 4 times, ch 1, dc in last st and change to C – Eight 3-st groups and 9 ch-1 sps.

**Row 3:** With C, ch 1, turn, sc in first ch-1 sp \*ch 3, sc in next sp; rep from \* along edge working last sc in 4th sp below top corner – 15 sc and 14 ch-3 sps. **Note:** As you work Row 3, take care to work sc in the ch-1 sp at the very beg of Row 2.

**Row 4:** Ch 1 (counts as ch-1 sp), turn, 3 sc in first ch-3 sp, ch 1, sk next sc, 3 sc in next ch-3 sp, (ch 1, sk next sc, 3 hdc in next ch-3 sp) 3 times, (ch 1, sk next sc, 3 dc in next ch-3 sp) 9 times, ch 1, dc in beg ch-1 – Fourteen 3-st groups and 15 ch-1 sps.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first ch-1 sp, \*ch 3, sc in next sp; rep from \* along edge working last sc in 2nd sp below top corner – 17 sc and 16 ch-3 sps.

**Row 6:** Ch 1 (counts as ch-1 sp), turn, 3 sc in first ch-3 sp, ch 1, sk next sc, 3 sc in next ch-3 sp, (ch 1, sk next sc, 3 hdc in next ch-3 sp) 3 times, (ch 1, sk next sc, 3 dc in next ch-3 sp) 11 times, ch 1, dc in beg ch-1 – Sixteen 3-st groups and 17 ch-1 sps.

Fasten off.

### **Size L/1X Only**

**Row 1 (RS):** From RS, join B with sc in lower left corner ch-2 sp, \*ch 3, sc in next sp; rep from \* all the way along left edge working last sc in lower left corner ch-2 sp – 19 sc and 18 ch-3 sps.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, 3 dc in first ch-3 sp, \*ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* across, ch 1, dc in last sc – Eighteen 3-dc groups and 18 ch-1 sps.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first ch-1 sp, \*ch 3, sc in next sp; rep from \* 7 more times – 9 sc and 8 ch-3 sps.

**Rows 4-8:** Work same as Rows 2-6 of "Left Side Panel - Size S/M Only" instructions (above).  
Fasten off.

### **BACK**

Make same as Front.

### **Cord**

With 2 strands of A held tog, make a chain about 70 in. (178 cm) long.

### **FINISHING**

#### **Join Front and Back**

Hold Front and Back with RS tog. From WS and working through both thicknesses along one side edge, join C with sc in corner at beg of side, \*ch 3, sc in next sp; rep from \* along side edge working last sc in opposite corner. Rep to join other side edge.

#### **Waistband**

From RS, join A with a sl st on top edge of Skirt at one side seam.

### **Size S/M Only**

**Rnd 1 (RS):** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), dc in center dc of next 3-dc group, \*ch 1, dc in next sp, ch 1, dc in center dc of next 3-dc group; rep from \* working last dc in center dc of 3-dc group before next side seam, ch 1, dc in seam, ch 1, dc in center dc of next 3-dc group, \*\*ch 1, dc in next sp, ch 1, dc in center dc of next 3-dc group; rep from \*\* around, ch 1; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch – 64 dc and 64 ch-1 sps.

**Rnds 2 and 3:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, dc in next dc, \*ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc; rep from \* to last ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk last ch-1 sp; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch.

Fasten off.

Beginning and ending at center front, weave Cord in and out of ch-1 sps of Rnd 2.

### **Size L/1X Only**

**Rnd 1 (RS):** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), dc in end of first row of side panel, ch 1, dc in end of next row, ch 1, dc in center dc of next 3-dc group, \*ch 1, dc in next

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sp, ch 1, dc in center dc of next 3-dc group; rep from \* working last dc in center dc of 3-dc group before next side panel, ch 1, dc in end of first row of side panel, ch 1, dc in end of next row, ch 1, dc in seam, (ch 1, dc in end of next row) twice, ch 1, dc in center dc of next 3-dc group, \*\*ch 1, dc in next sp, ch 1, dc in center dc of next 3-dc group; rep from \*\* working last dc in center dc of last 3-dc group, ch 1, dc in end of first row of side panel, ch 1, dc in end of next row, ch 1; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch – 72 dc and 72 ch-1 sps.

**Rnds 2 and 3:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, dc in next dc, \*ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc; rep from \* to last ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk last ch-1 sp; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch.

Fasten off.

Beginning and ending at center front, weave Cord in and out of ch-1 sps of Rnd 2.

### Flounce

**Rnd 1 (RS):** From RS, join D with an sc on lower edge of Skirt at one side seam, \*ch 3, sk next 3-st group or end of row, sc in next sp or end of row; rep from \* around, ch 3; join with sl st in first sc – 44 (48) sc and 44 (48) ch-3 sps.

**Rnd 2:** Turn, (sl st, ch 1, 3 sc) in first ch-3 sp, \*ch 1, sk next sc, 3 sc in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* around, ch 1; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnd 3:** Turn, (sl st, ch 1, sc) in first ch-1 sp, \*ch 3, sk next 3-st group, sc in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* around, ch 3; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnd 4:** Turn, (sl st, ch 1, 3 hdc) in first ch-3 sp, \*ch 1, sk next sc, 3 hdc in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* around, ch 1; join with sl st in first hdc.

**Rnd 5:** Rep Rnd 3.

**Rnd 6:** Turn, sl st in first ch-3 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same ch-3 sp, \*ch 1, sk next sc, 3 dc in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* around, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch.

**Rnd 7:** Rep Rnd 3.

**Rnd 8:** Turn, sl st in first ch-3 sp, ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), (dc, ch 1, dc) in same ch-3 sp, \*ch 1, sk next sc, (dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* around, ch 1; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch.

**Rnd 9:** Turn, sl st in first ch-1 sp, \*ch 3, sl st in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* around, ch 3; join with sl st in first sl st.

**Rnds 10 and 11:** Turn, sl st in first ch-1 sp, \*ch 3, sl st in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* around, ch 3; join with sl st in first sl st.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

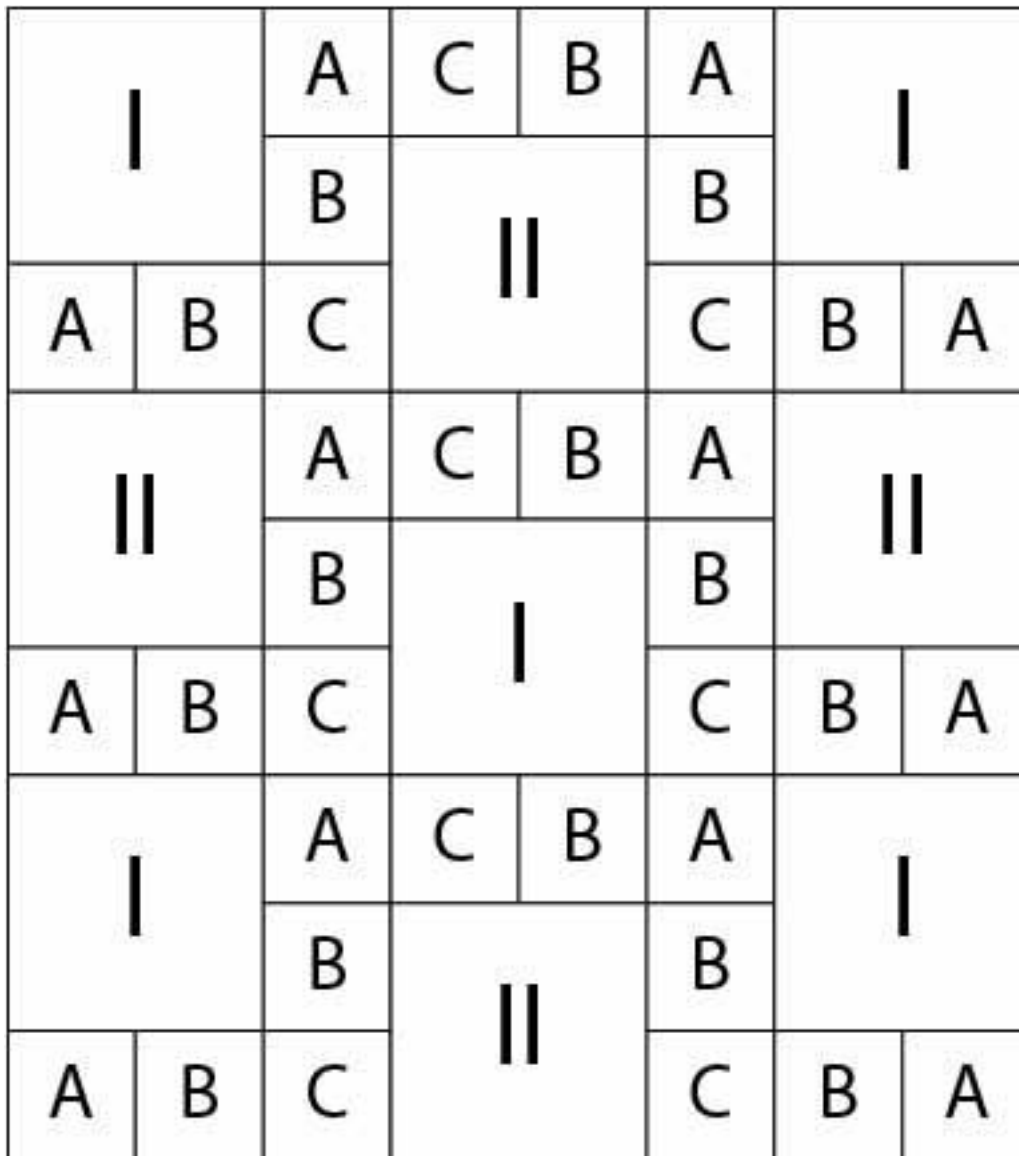
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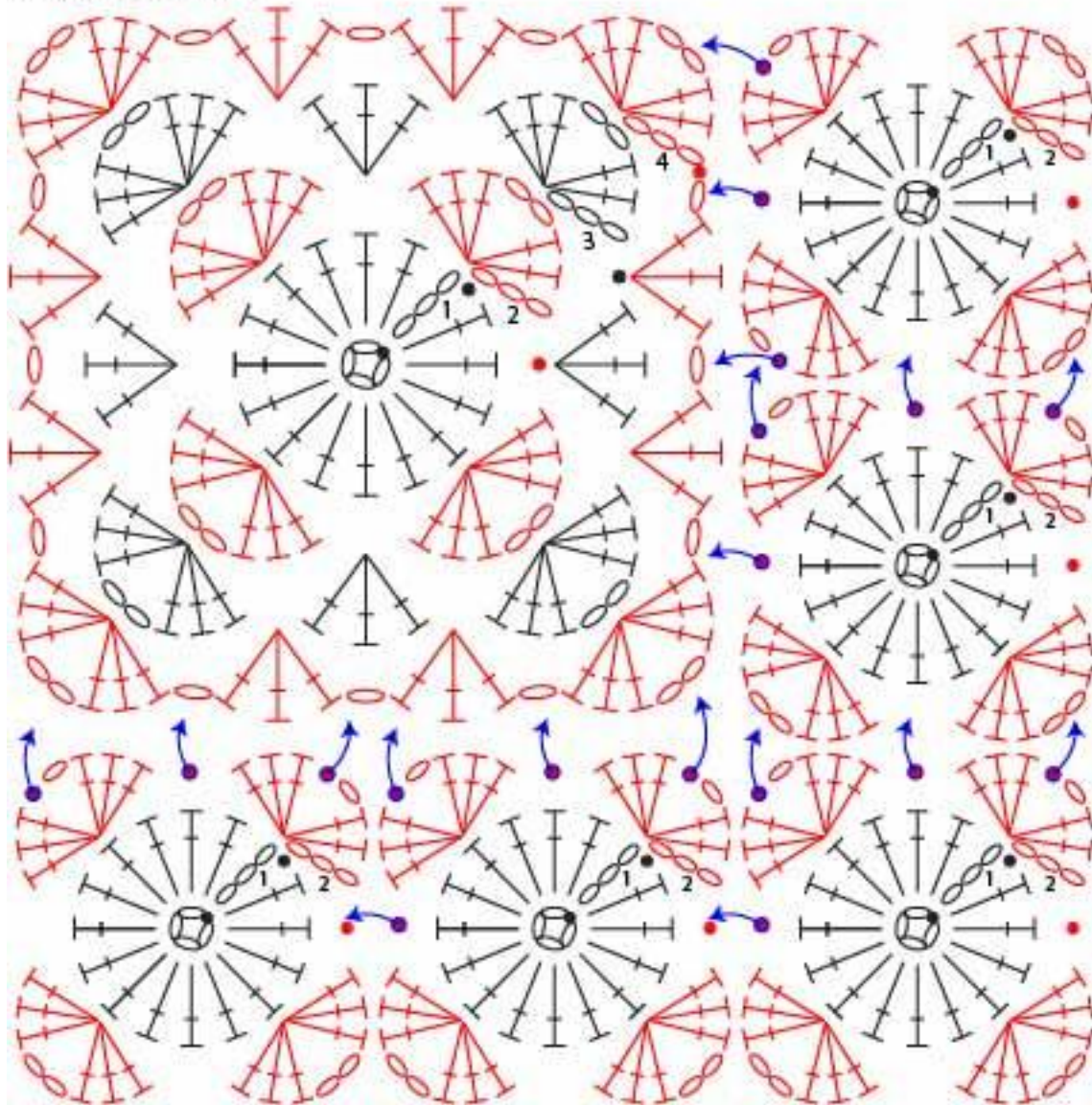
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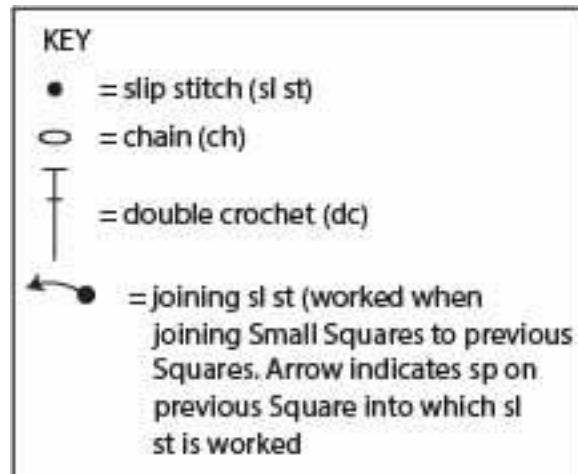
