**Lion Brand® Landscapes®**  
**Los Lunas Scarf**

## **SKILL LEVEL – Easy**

### **SIZE**

7 1/2 x 42 in. (19 x 106.5 cm)

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Landscapes® (Art. #545)
  - 220 Twilight 2 balls
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



### **GAUGE**

16 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (knit every stitch on every row).  
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

### **STITCH EXPLANATION**

#### **kfb (knit into front and then back)**

An increase worked as follows:

1. Knit the next st through the front loop, but do not remove the st from your left hand needle.
2. Knit the same st once more, this time inserting your needle through the back loop of the st. You will have created 2 loops (sts) on your right hand needle.
3. Drop the st from your left hand needle – you have increased 1 st.

### **NOTE**

Scarf is worked in one piece in Garter st (knit every stitch on every row), working increases and decreases to create a diagonal color pattern.

### **SCARF**

Cast on 3 sts.

Knit one row.

**Row 1:** K1, kfb, k to end of row – you will have 4 sts at the end of Row 1.

Rep Row 1 until you have 40 sts.

**Next Row:** K1, kfb, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

**Next Row:** K1, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1.

Rep the last 2 rows until piece measures about 42 in. (106.5 cm) from beginning along longest side.

**Next Row:** K1, k2tog, k to end of row – 39 sts.

Rep the last row until you have 3 sts.

Knit one row.

Bind off.

### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

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## **ABBREVIATIONS**

k = knit

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

st(s) = stitch(es)
