## **SKILL LEVEL – Easy**

### **SIZE**

About 44 x 57 in. (112 x 145 cm)

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® 24/7 Cotton® (Art. #761)
  - 133 Tangerine 3 balls (A)
  - 124 Camel 3 balls (B)
  - 178 Jade 3 balls (C)
  - 172 Grass 3 balls (D)
  - 142 Rose 3 balls (E)
  - 144 Magenta 3 balls (F)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand large-eyed blunt needle



### **GAUGE**

1 ripple = about 3 in. (7.5 cm) measured from peak to peak.

**BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**

### **NOTES**

1. The Afghan is worked in a ripple crochet pattern. The ripple pattern is easy to do, but it's important to remember that you may need to work several rows before the ripple pattern becomes clear.
2. Six yarn colors are used following a Color Sequence.
3. To change yarn color, fasten off old color and join new color with a sl st as instructed.
4. The ripple in this design is created by skipping 2 sts to form valleys and working 3 dc all in the same st to form peaks. In each row, take care to skip the 2 sts in each valley and work 3 dc at each peak.
5. For those who find a visual helpful, we've included a stitch diagram.

### **COLOR SEQUENCE**

Work \*6 rows each with A, B, C, D, E, F; rep from \* twice more – 108 rows.

### **AFGHAN**

With A, ch 182.

**Row 1:** Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as dc), dc in next 3 ch, 3 dc in next ch, dc in next 5 ch, \*sk next 2 ch, dc in next 5 ch, 3 dc in next ch, dc in next 5 ch; rep from \* across – you will have 14 ripples in this row.

**Row 2:** Turn, sk first dc, sl st in next dc, ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next 4 dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next 5 dc, \*sk next 2 dc, dc in next 5 dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next 5 dc; rep from \* across; leave beg ch-3 unworked.

**Rows 3-6:** With A, rep Row 2.

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**Row 7:** Turn, sk first dc, join B with a sl st in next dc, ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next 4 dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next 5 dc, \*sk next 2 dc, dc in next 5 dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next 5 dc; rep from \* across; leave beg ch-3 unworked.

**Rows 8-12:** With B, rep Row 2.

Continue following Color Sequence, rep Rows 7-12, changing yarn color every 6 rows until all 108 rows of Color Sequence have been worked.

Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.


