## **SKILL LEVEL – Easy+**

### **SIZES**

S (M, L, 1X, 2X)

**Finished Bust** About 42 (46, 50, 54, 58) in. (106.5 (117, 127, 137, 147.5) cm)

**Finished Length** About 27 (27 1/2, 28, 28 1/2, 29) in. (68.5 (70, 71, 72.5, 73.5) cm)

**Note:** Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Touch of Mohair (Art. #677)
  - 147 Purple Haze 3 (4, 4, 5, 5) balls
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 6 (4 mm)
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

### **ADDITIONAL MATERIALS**

Circular knitting needle size 6 (4 mm), 16 in. (40.5 cm) long

### **GAUGE**

16 1/2 sts + 21 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS) with larger needle.

19 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in P2, k2 Rib.

**BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**

### **STITCH EXPLANATION**

**M1 (make 1)** An increase worked by lifting the horizontal strand lying between needles and placing it onto the left needle. Knit this new stitch through the back loop – 1 st increased.

### **PATTERN STITCHES**

**P2, k2 Rib worked in rows (multiple of 4 sts + 2 additional sts)**

**Row 1 (RS):** P2, \*k2, p2; rep from \* to end of row.

**Row 2:** K the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 for P2, k2 Rib worked in rows.

**P2, k2 Rib worked in rnds (multiple of 4 sts)**

**Rnd 1 (RS):** \*P2, k2; rep from \* to end of rnd.

**Rnd 2:** K the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Rep Rnd 2 for P2, k2 Rib worked in rnds.

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## **NOTES**

1. Pullover is worked in 4 pieces: Back, Front and 2 Sleeves.
2. Each piece is worked back and forth in rows from the lower edge upwards.
3. The turtleneck is worked from stitches picked up around the neck edge.
4. When you see 'work even' in the instructions, this means to continue on in the pattern st you have established without changing the st count by increasing, decreasing, or binding off.
5. When you see 'work in pattern as established' in the instructions, this means to work the next row of the pattern sts, lining up sts as in previous rows.

## **BACK**

With smaller straight needles, cast on 94 (102, 118, 126, 134) sts.

Work in P2, k2 Rib worked in rows until piece measures about 3 in. (7.5 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

**Next Row (Decrease Row – RS):** (K6 (7, 5, 5, 6), k2tog) 4 (4, 7, 7, 7) times, k30 (30, 20, 28, 22), (k2tog, k6 (7, 5, 5, 6)) 4 (4, 7, 7, 7) times – you will have 86 (94, 104, 112, 120) sts in this row.

Change to larger straight needles.

Work even in St st (k on RS, p on WS) until piece measures about 24 1/2 (25, 25 1/2, 26, 26 1/2) in. (62 (63.5, 65, 66, 67.5) cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

## **Shape Shoulders**

**Row 1 (RS):** Bind off 4 (5, 6, 7, 8) sts, k to end of row – 82 (89, 98, 105, 112) sts.

**Row 2:** Bind off 4 (5, 6, 7, 8) sts, p to end of row – 78 (84, 92, 98, 104) sts.

**Rows 3 and 4:** Rep Rows 1 and 2 – 70 (74, 80, 84, 88) sts.

## **Shape Neck and Continue Shaping Shoulders**

Place a marker on each side of center 16 (16, 18, 18, 20) sts.

**Row 5:** Bind off 4 (5, 6, 7, 8) sts, k to first marker for right side; join a 2nd ball of yarn and bind off center 16 (16, 18, 18, 20) sts for neck removing markers, k to end of row for left side – 23 (24, 25, 26, 26) sts for right side and 27 (29, 31, 33, 34) sts for left side.

You will now work both sides AT THE SAME TIME with separate balls of yarn.

**Row 6:** On left side, bind off 4 (5, 6, 7, 8) sts, p to end; on right side, bind off 3 sts, p to end – 20 (21, 22, 23, 23) sts for right side and 23 (24, 25, 26, 26) sts for left side.

**Row 7:** On right side, bind off 5 sts, k to end; on left side, bind off 3 sts, k to end – 15 (16, 17, 18, 18) sts for right side and 20 (21, 22, 23, 23) sts for left side.

**Row 8:** On left side, bind off 5 sts, p to end; on right side, bind off 2 sts, p to end – 13 (14, 15, 16, 16) sts for right side and 15 (16, 17, 18, 18) sts for left side.

**Row 9:** On right side, bind off 6 (6, 7, 7, 7) sts, k to end; on left side, bind off 2 sts, k to end – 7 (8, 8, 9, 9) sts for right side and 13 (14, 15, 16, 16) sts for left side.

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**Row 10:** On left side, bind off 6 (6, 7, 7, 7) sts, p to end; on right side, bind off 1 st, p to end – 6 (7, 7, 8, 8) sts for right side and 7 (8, 8, 9, 9) sts for left side.

**Row 11:** On right side, bind off rem 6 (7, 7, 8, 8) sts; on left side, bind off 1 st, k to end – 6 (7, 7, 8, 8) sts rem for left side.

Bind off rem 6 (7, 7, 8, 8) sts of left side.

## FRONT

With smaller straight needles, cast on 94 (102, 118, 126, 134) sts.

Work in P2, k2 Rib worked in rows until piece measures about 3 in. (7.5 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work. **Note:** On RS, the center 2 sts will be knit sts.

**Next Row (Decrease Row – RS):** (K6 (7, 5, 5, 6), k2tog) 4 (4, 7, 7, 7) times, k8 (8, 3, 7, 4), place marker (pm), work in P2, k2 Rib as established over center 14 sts, pm, k8 (8, 3, 7 4), (k2tog, k6 (7, 5, 5, 6)) 4 (4, 7, 7, 7) times – 86 (94, 104, 112, 120) sts.

Change to larger straight needles.

**Next Row:** Work in St st to marker, slip marker (sm), work in P2, k2 Rib as established to next marker, sm, work in St st to end of row.

Rep last row until piece measures about 23 1/2 (24, 24 1/2, 25, 25 1/2) in. (59.5 (61, 62, 63.5, 65) cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work. Remove markers.

## Shape Neck

Place a marker on each side of center 10 (10, 12, 12, 14) sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K to first marker for left side; join a 2nd ball of yarn and bind off center 10 (10, 12, 12, 14) sts for neck removing markers, k to end of row for right side – 38 (42, 46, 50, 53) sts for each side.

You will now work both sides AT THE SAME TIME with separate balls of yarn.

**Row 2:** On right side, p to end; on left side, bind off 3 sts, p to end – 35 (39, 43, 47, 50) sts for left side and 38 (42, 46, 50, 53) sts for right side.

**Row 3:** On left side, k to end; on right side, bind off 3 sts, k to end – 35 (39, 43, 47, 50) sts for each side.

**Row 4:** On right side, p to end; on left side, bind off 2 sts, p to end – 33 (37, 41, 45, 48) sts for left side and 35 (39, 43, 47, 50) sts for right side.

**Row 5:** On left side, k to end; on right side, bind off 2 sts, k to end – 33 (37, 41, 45, 48) sts for each side.

**Row 6:** Rep Row 4 – 31 (35, 39, 43, 46) sts for left side and 33 (37, 41, 45, 48) sts for right side.

## Shape Shoulders and Continue Shaping Neck

**Row 7:** On left side, bind off 4 (5, 6, 7, 8) sts, k to end; on right side, bind off 2 sts, k to end – 27 (30, 33, 36, 38) sts for left side and 31 (35, 39, 43, 46) sts for right side.

**Row 8:** On right side, bind off 4 (5, 6, 7, 8) sts, p to end; on left side bind off 1 st, p to end – 26 (29, 32, 35, 37) sts for left side and 27 (30, 33, 36, 38) sts for right side.

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**Row 9:** On left side, bind off 4 (5, 6, 7, 8) sts, k to end; on right side, bind off 1 sts, k to end – 22 (24, 26, 28, 29) sts for left side and 26 (29, 32, 35, 37) sts for right side.

**Row 10:** Rep Row 8 – 21 (23, 25, 27, 28) sts on left side and 22 (24, 26, 28, 29) sts on right side.

**Row 11:** On left side, bind off 4 (5, 6, 7, 8) sts, k to end; on right side, bind off 1 st, k to end – 17 (18, 19, 20, 20) sts for left side and 21 (23, 25, 27, 28) sts for right side.

**Row 12:** On right side, bind off 4 (5, 6, 7, 8) sts, p to end; on left side, p to end – 17 (18, 19, 20, 20) sts for each side.

**Row 13:** On left side, bind off 5 sts, k to end; on right side, k to end – 12 (13, 14, 15, 15) sts for left side and 17 (18, 19, 20, 20) sts for right side.

**Row 14:** On right side, bind off 5 sts, p to end; on left side, p to end – 12 (13, 14, 15, 15) sts for each side.

**Row 15:** On left side, bind off 6 (6, 7, 7, 7) sts, k to end; on right side, k to end – 6 (7, 7, 8, 8) sts for left side and 12 (13, 14, 15, 15) sts for right side.

**Row 16:** On right side, bind off 6 (6, 7, 7, 7) sts, p to end; on left side, p to end – 6 (7, 7, 8, 8) sts for each side.

**Row 17:** On left side, bind off rem 6 (7, 7, 8, 8) sts; on right side, k to end – 6 (7, 7, 8, 8) sts rem for right side.

Bind off rem 6 (7, 7, 8, 8) sts of right side.

## **SLEEVES (make 2)**

With smaller straight needles, cast on 38 (38, 42, 42, 42) sts.

Work in P2, k2 Rib until piece measures about 2 1/2 in. (6.5 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

**Next Row (Increase Row – RS):** K7 (7, 7, 3, 3), M1, (k8 (4, 4, 4, 4), M1) 3 (6, 7, 9, 9) times, k to end of row – 42 (45, 50, 52, 52) sts.

Change to larger straight needles.

Work in St st for 7 (7, 7, 5, 5) rows.

**Increase Row (RS):** K1, M1, k to last st, M1, k1 – 44 (47, 52, 54, 54) sts.

Rep last 8 (8, 8, 6, 6) rows for 9 (9, 9, 10, 12) more times – 62 (65, 70, 74, 78) sts.

Work even in St st until piece measures about 18 1/2 in. (47 cm) from beg.

Bind off.

## **FINISHING**

Sew shoulder seams.

## **Turtleneck**

From RS with circular needle, beg at one shoulder seam, pick up and k84 (84, 92, 92, 96) sts evenly spaced around neck edge – 84 (84, 92, 92, 96) sts.

Place marker for beg of rnd. Join by working the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle.

Lining up sts so that you keep center front 14 sts in rib pattern as established, work in P2, k2 Rib worked in rnds for about 5 in. (12.5 cm).

Bind off.

Fold turtleneck in half to the inside and sew in place.

Place markers on edges of Front and Back about 7 1/2 (8, 8 1/2, 9, 9 1/2) in. (19 (20.5, 21.5, 23, 24) cm) from shoulders seams. Sew tops of Sleeves between markers. Remove markers.

Sew side and Sleeve seams, leaving edges of lower ribbing open for side slits.

Weave in ends.
